COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, SEPTEIBER 1st, 1928.

The butter in storage amounts to 28,650,703 pounds of creamery and 615,159 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows an increase of 25.39% over last month and a decrease of 15.18% from last year; and dairy butter also shows an increase of 47.76% over last month and a decrease of 12.57% from last year.

Cheese stocks total 27,854,470 pounds showing an increase of 18.19% over last month and a decrease of 22.25% from last year.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 15,168,879 dozen; eggs, other than cold storage 1,201,417 dozen, and frozen eggs 3,455,406 pounds. Cold storage eggs show decreases of 4.92% from last month and .51% from last year; eggs, other than cold storage show increases of 86.56% over last month and 54.78% over last year, while frozen eggs also show increases of 15.32% and 100.61% over last month and last year respectively.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 11,441,248 pounds; fresh, not frozen 3,224,545 pounds; cured, dry salted 3,364,708 pounds; cured, sweet pickled 7,703,149 pounds; in process of cure 5,826,321 pounds. Comparative figures show fresh frozen stocks to have decreased 32.66% from last month and to have increased 8.48% over last year; while stocks, not frozen show increases of 36.11% over last month and 72.80% over last year. Cured, dry salted stocks show increases of .19% over last month and 48.74% over last year; cured, sweet pickled show a decrease of 26.84% from last month and an increase of 12.64% over last year; while stocks, in process of cure show decreases of 6.47% and 45.08% from last month and last year respectively.

The lard in storage amounts to 4,129,766 pounds, showing decreases of 22.39% from last month and 9.85% from last year.

Beef in storage amounts to 2,599,456 pounds of fresh frozen; 4,994,213 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 296,582 pounds of cured and 172,943 pounds of beef, in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show an increase of 17.68% over last month and a decrease of 27.64% from last year, while stocks, not frozen show decreases of 3.71% from last month and 8.59% from last year. Cured stocks show an increase of 13.30% over last month and a decrease of 14.34% from last year and stocks, in process of cure also show an increase of 29.72% over last month and a decrease of 33.54% from last year.


Veal in storage amounts to 826,015 pounds of fresh frozen and 370,044 pounds of fresh, not frozen. Comparative figures show increases in fresh frozen stocks of 18.09% over last month and 11.30% over last year, and in fresh stocks, not frozen, decreases of 24.28% from last month and 30.00% from last year.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 340,166 pounds of frozen and 290,644 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show a decrease of 5.08% from last month and an increase of 16.65% over last year, while stocks, not frozen show increases of 46.56% and 19.18% over last month and last year respectively.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 204,173 pounds, chickens 235,952 pounds; fowl 198,932 pounds; ducks 80,255 pounds; geese 21,006 pounds; turkeys 393,584 pounds; unclassified 272,571 pounds. Total poultry shows decreases of 30.70% from last month and 40.68% from last year.


Fish stocks total 20,612,087 pounds of fresh frozen and 5,050,330 pounds of other fish in cold storage. Fresh frozen fish shows increases of 5.49% over last month and 4.36% over last year; while other fish in cold storage shows a decrease of 1.77% from last month and an increase of .23% over last year.

During the month of August 2,343,531 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 3,635,572 pounds frozen during the month of July.
