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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OCTOBER 1, 1929.

The butter in storage amounts to 26,392,382 pounds of creamery and 430,758 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows a decrease of 7.95% from last year and an increase of 4.56% over last month, while dairy butter shows decreases of 39.73% from last year and 36.70% from last month.

Cheese stocks total 30,531,207 pounds, which is an increase of 9.80% over last year and a decrease of 10.73% from last month.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 13,975,529 dozen; other than cold storage 762,244 dozen; and frozen eggs 2,673,158 pounds. Cold storage eggs show decreases of 6.82% and 12.22% from last year and last month, respectively; other than cold storage eggs show increases of 26.51% and .60%; and frozen eggs show decreases of 14.09% and 21.29%.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 4,361,659 pounds; fresh, not frozen 2,351,071 pounds; cured, dry salted 1,285,458 pounds; cured, sweet pickled 6,431,826 pounds; and in process of cure 7,403,442 pounds. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 45.96% from last year and 47.00% from last month; fresh, not frozen stocks show decreases of 34.20% and 8.17%, respectively; cured, dry salted stocks show decreases of 34.24% and 18.09%; cured, sweet pickled stocks show decreases of 20.09% and 11.80%; and stocks in process of cure show an increase of 4.90% over last year and a decrease of 7.36% from last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 3,310,710 pounds, being a decrease of 6.14% from last year and 31.51% from last month.

Beef stocks total 4,133,931 pounds of fresh frozen; 5,581,415 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 264,904 pounds of cured; and 199,115 pounds of beef in process of cure. Fresh frozen beef has increased 41.11% over last year and 1.61% over last month; fresh, not frozen beef shows a decrease of 7.19% from last year and an increase of 24.98% over last month; cured beef shows an increase of 2.70% over last year and a decrease of 32.76% from last month, and beef in process of cure shows an increase of 14.40% over last year and a decrease of 4.37% from last month.


The veal in cold storage amounts to 1,744,123 pounds of fresh frozen and 597,972 pounds of fresh, not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 114.68% over last year and 1.19% over last month and stocks not frozen show increases of 23.11% and 30.25% over last year and last month, respectively.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 799,509 pounds of frozen and 400,183 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show increases of 11.78% over last year and 94.55% over last month, and stocks not frozen show decreases of 6.04% from last year and 5.44% from last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 302,724 pounds; chickens 488,944 pounds; fowl 432,230 pounds; ducks 83,371 pounds; geese 28,531 pounds; turkeys 544,209 pounds; unclassified 341,853 pounds. Total poultry shows an increase of 63.87% over last year and a decrease of 2.32% from last month.

Fish stocks total 23,072,474 pounds of fresh frozen and 6,455,207 pounds of other fish in cold storage. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of .61% over last year and 10.74% over last month and other fish in cold storage also shows increases of 23.50% over last year and .59% over last month.

During the month of September 4,676,057 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 5,632,611 pounds during the month of August.
