The butter in storage amounts to 23,449,339 pounds of creamery and 564,235 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows decreases of 6.32% from last year and 12.81% from last month, while dairy butter shows a decrease of 41.58% from last year and an increase of 30.99% over last month.

Cheese stocks total 24,398,231 pounds, which shows an increase of .06% over last year and a decrease of 20.19% from last month.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 9,031,050 dozen; other than cold storage 409,414 dozen; and frozen eggs 3,180,157 pounds. Eggs in cold storage show decreases of 12.93% from last year and 34.93% from last month; other than cold storage eggs also show decreases of 10.76% from last year and 47.32% from last month, while frozen eggs show a decrease of 9.78% from last year and an increase of 18.75% over last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 3,320,173 pounds; fresh, not frozen 2,776,184 pounds; cured, dry salted 1,256,504 pounds; cured, sweet pickled 6,658,620 pounds; and in process of cure 6,150,533 pounds. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 39.16% from last year and 23.91% from last month; fresh, not frozen stocks show a decrease of 24.39% from last year and an increase of 19.20% over last month; cured, dry salted stocks show an increase of 3.15% over last year and a decrease of 2.24% from last month; cured, sweet pickled stocks show a decrease of 10.14% from last year and an increase of 3.77% over last month; and stocks in process of cure show an increase of 5.18% over last year and a decrease of 16.62% from last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 2,824,108 pounds, showing an increase of 4.76% over last year and a decrease of 14.21% from last month.

Beef stocks total 9,886,754 pounds of fresh frozen; 6,036,717 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 250,212 pounds of cured; and 197,985 pounds of beef in process of cure. Fresh frozen beef shows increases of 38.29% over last year and 139.17% over last month; fresh, not frozen beef shows a decrease of 4.84% from last year and an increase of 8.02% over last month; cured beef shows an increase of 59.34% over last year and a decrease of 2.23% from last month, and beef in process of cure shows decreases of 19.72% and .57% from last year and last month respectively.

The veal in cold storage amounts to 2,505,120 pounds of fresh frozen and 716,980 pounds of fresh, not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 87.60% over last year and 43.74% over last month, and stocks not frozen also show increases of 56.09 over last year and 19.91% over last month.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 4,057,904 pounds of frozen and 656,499 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show increases of 28.51% over last year and 417.17% over last month, and stocks not frozen also show increases of 8.82% over last year and 65.89% over last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 406,483 pounds; chickens 955,236 pounds; fowl 1,089,562 pounds; ducks 92,619 pounds; geese 28,833 pounds; Turkeys 457,456 pounds; unclassified 652,205 pounds. Total poultry shows increases of 80.33% and 64.57% over last year and last month respectively.

Fish stocks total 26,922,972 pounds of fresh frozen and 5,452,908 pounds of other fish in cold storage. Fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of .68% from last year and an increase of 17.71% over last month, and other fish in cold storage shows decreases of .55% from last year and 17.66% from last month.


During the month of October 6,426,337 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 4,676,057 pounds frozen during the month of September.
