The butter in storage amounts to 17,822,810 pounds of creamery and 294,281 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows an increase of 3.50% over last year and a decrease of 24.06% from last month, and dairy butter shows decreases of 51.32% and 47.84% from last year and last month respectively.

Cheese stocks total 14,206,948 pounds, showing decreases of 27.26% from last year and 41.77% from last month.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 4,359,637 dozen; other than cold storage 587,475 dozen; and frozen eggs 2,769,313 pounds. Eggs in cold storage show decreases of 28.30% from last year and 51.80% from last month; other than cold storage eggs show an increase of 78.85% over last year and an increase of 42.78% over last month; and frozen eggs show decreases of 6.51% from last year and 12.92% from last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 6,971,585 pounds; fresh not frozen 2,933,711 pounds; cured dry salted 1,444,795 pounds; cured sweet pickled 7,340,843 pounds; in process of cure 6,595,959 pounds. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 10.24% over last year and 109.22% over last month; fresh not frozen stocks show a decrease of 22.51% from last year and an increase of 5.28% over last month; cured dry salted stocks show a decrease of 36.18% from last year and an increase of 14.39% over last month; cured sweet pickled stocks show increases of 11.37% over last year and 10.18% over last month; and stocks in process of cure also show increases of 12.93% and 6.77% over last year and last month respectively.

The lard in storage amounts to 2,684,505 pounds showing an increase of 36.75% over last year and a decrease of 4.74% from last month.

Beef stocks total 18,261,718 pounds of fresh frozen; 6,446,957 pounds of fresh not frozen; 216,304 pounds of cured; and 229,903 pounds of stocks in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 37.55% over last year and 84.57% over last month; fresh not frozen also show increases of 6.88% over last year and 6.96% over last month; cured stocks show decreases of 38.76% from last year and 13.24% from last month; while stocks in process of cure show increases of 125.61% over last year and 16.12% over last month.


The veal in cold storage amounts to 3,148,802 pounds of fresh frozen and 362,675 pounds of fresh not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 82.58% over last year and 25.72% over last month. and fresh stocks not frozen show an increase of 37.10% over last year and a decrease of 49.42% from last month.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 7,183,043 pounds of frozen and 602,172 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show increases of 36.50% over last year and 76.57% over last month; and stocks not frozen show an increase of 20.69% over last year and a decrease of 7.52% from last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 497,429 pounds; chickens 2,538,013 pounds; fowl 1,737,279 pounds; ducks 102,212 pounds; geese 238,195 pounds; turkeys 666,089 pounds; unclassified 1,474,187 pounds. Total poultry shows increases of 57.21% and 99.17% over last year and last month respectively.

Fish stocks total 24,858,815 pounds of fresh frozen and 6,493,993 pounds of other fish in cold storage. Fresh frozen stocks show an increase of 1.75% over last year and a decrease of 9.61% from last month; and other in cold storage shows increases of 11.62% over last year and 18.60% over last month.


During the month of November 4,660,959 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 6,426,337 pounds frozen during October.
