COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, JUNE 1, 1929.

The butter in storage amounts to 3,124,850 pounds of creamery and 66,874 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows a decrease of 5.45% from last year and an increase of 21.90% over last month; and dairy butter also shows a decrease of 5.31% from last year and an increase of 17.79% over last month.

Cheese stocks total 10,509,623 pounds in store, showing an increase of 15.81% over last year and a decrease of 8.95% from last month.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 11,726,238 dozen; other than cold storage 1,002,303 dozen; and frozen eggs 2,318,334 pounds. Cold storage eggs show increases of 4.06% over last year and 120.69% over last month; eggs, other than cold storage show increases of 63.46% over last year and 33.83% over last month; while frozen eggs also show increases of 7.34% and 2.16% over last year and last month, respectively.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen, 20,672,349 pounds; fresh, not frozen 2,632,311 pounds; cured, dry salted 2,523,881 pounds; cured, sweet pickled 9,081,014 pounds; in process of cure 9,165,737 pounds. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 22.58% from last year and 9.90% from last month; and fresh stocks, not frozen also show decreases of 17.08% from last year and 16.75% from last month. Cured, dry salted stocks show a decrease of 35.55% from last year and an increase of 15.05% over last month; cured, sweet pickled stocks also show a decrease of 23.10% from last year and an increase of 20.00% over last month; while stocks in process of cure show an increase of 38.17% over last year and a decrease of 13.26% from last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 5,343,003 pounds, showing increases of 35.58% and 5.50% over last year and last month, respectively.

Beef stocks total 4,739,027 pounds of fresh frozen; 4,095,606 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 368,548 pounds of cured; and 149,068 pounds of beef, in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show an increase of 23.14% over last year and a decrease of 35.57% from last month; while fresh stocks, not frozen, show a decrease of 12.47% from last year and an increase of 16.88% over last month. Cured stocks show an increase of 140.99% over last year and a decrease of 13.94% from last month; and stocks, in process of cure also show an increase of 25.30% over last year and a decrease of 13.21% from last month.

Veal in storage amounts to 1,152,159 pounds of fresh frozen and 611,435 pounds of fresh, not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 127.83% over last year and 55.38% over last month; and fresh stocks, not frozen, also show increases of 2.93% and 28.89% over last year and last month, respectively.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 1,306,849 pounds of frozen and 291,460 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show an increase of 28.81% over last year and a decrease of 49.83% from last month; and stocks, not frozen, also show an increase of 159.53% over last year and a decrease of 29.50% from last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 179,343 pounds; chickens 1,420,566 pounds; fowl 340,759 pounds; ducks 64,705 pounds; geese 37,446 pounds; turkeys 1,156,440 pounds; unclassified 633,390 pounds. Total poultry shows an increase of 4.88% over last year and a decrease of 22.18% from last month.

Fish stocks total 13,062,324 pounds of fresh frozen and 4,434,418 pounds of other fish in cold storage. Fresh frozen fish shows an increase of 11.48% over last year and a decrease of 7.26% from last month; while other fish in cold storage shows a decrease of 15.65% from last year and an increase of 4.69% over last month.

During the month of May, 2,137,081 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 955,683 pounds frozen during April.

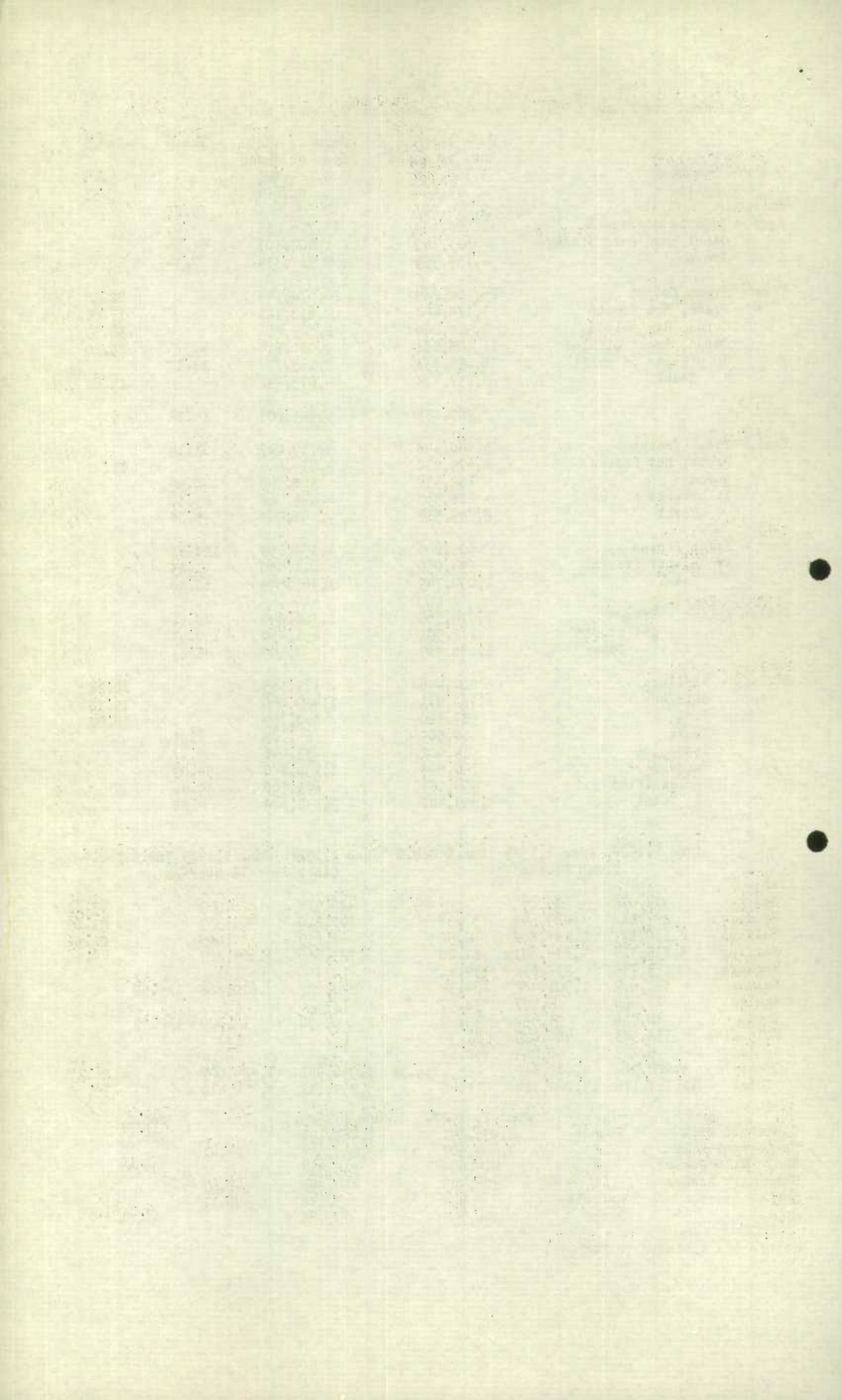

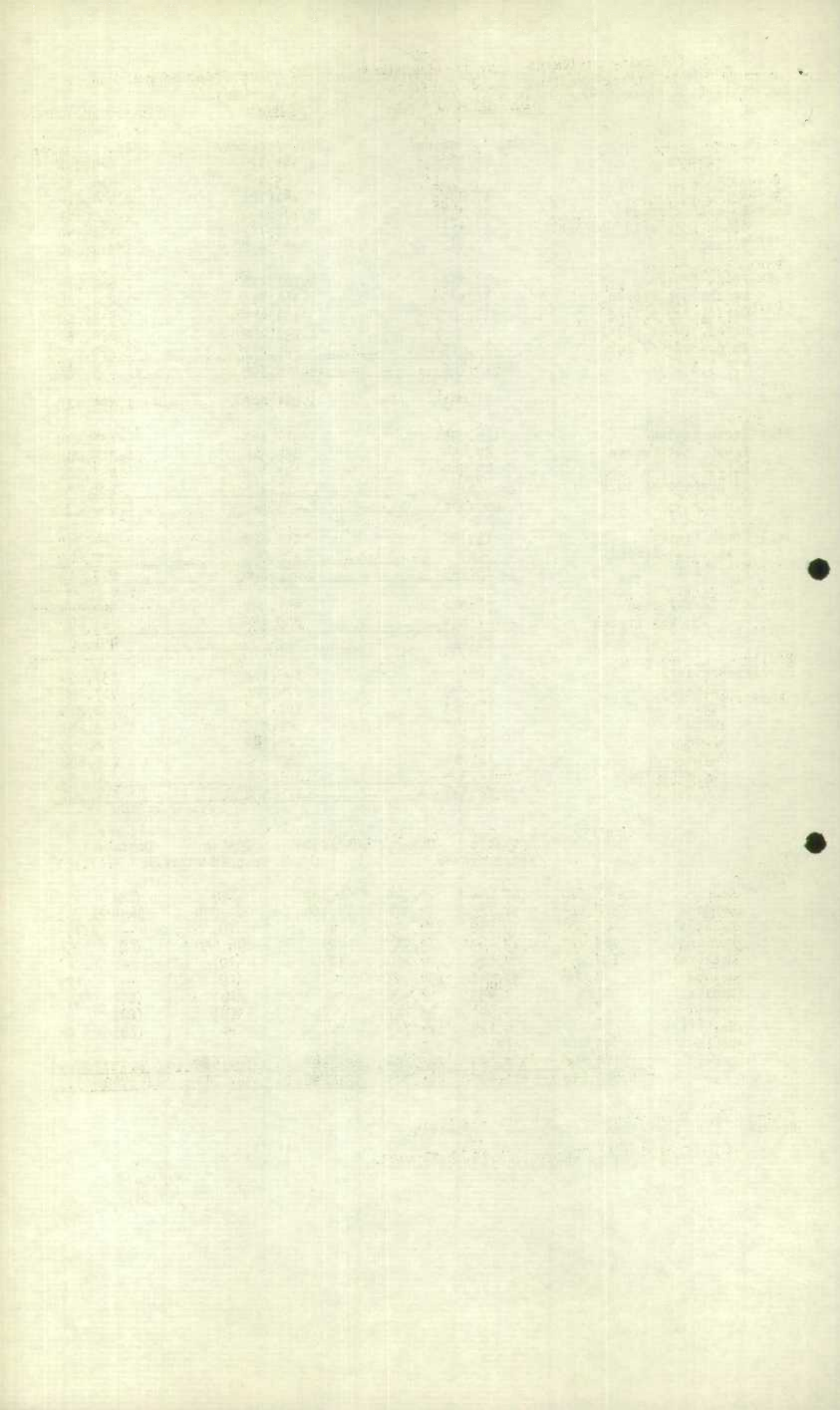

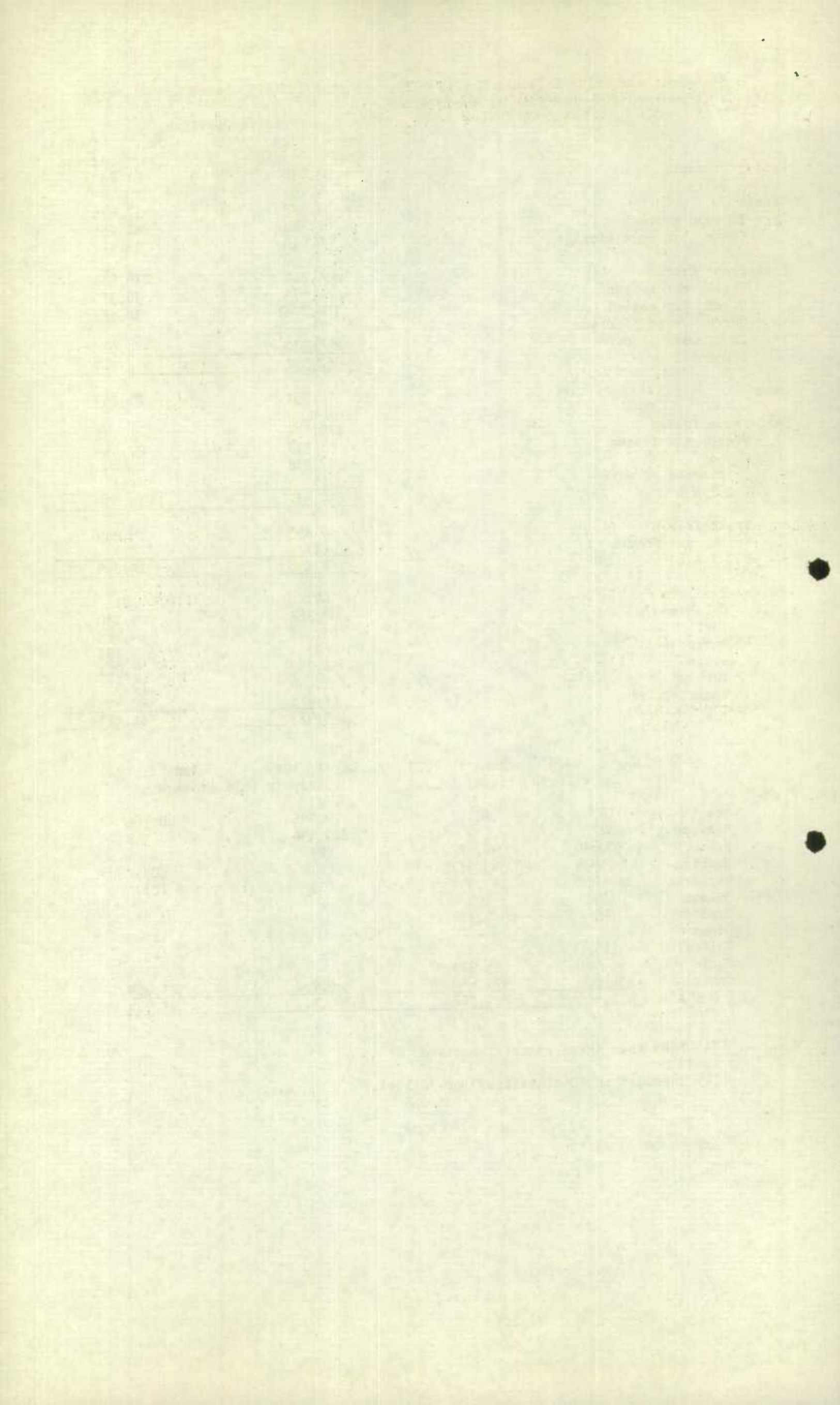
