COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, AUGUST 1, 1929.

The butter in storage amounts to 20,839,032 pounds of creamery and 371,128 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows a decrease of 8.01% from last year and an increase of 85.46% over last month; and dairy butter also shows a decrease of 6.14% from last year and an increase of 86.53% over last month.

Cheese stocks total 28,319,426 pounds, showing increases of 20.16% and 57.54% over last year and last month respectively.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 16,018,135 dozen; other than cold storage 1,809,692 dozen; and frozen eggs 3,29,837 pounds. Cold storage eggs show an increase of 1.39% over last year and a decrease of 2.83% from last month; eggs, other than cold storage show increases of 179.63% over last year and 123.78% over last month; and frozen eggs show an increase of 12.73% over last year and a decrease of 7.98% from last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 10,259,641 pounds; fresh, not frozen 2,974,208 pounds; cured, dry salted 1,785,743 pounds; cured, sweet pickled 8,020,031 pounds; in process of cure 8,813,255 pounds. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 40.46% from last year and 33.89% from last month; and fresh stocks, not frozen show an increase of 24.06% over last year and a decrease of 19.12% from last month. Cured, dry salted stocks show a decrease of 46.97% from last year and an increase of 3.06% over last month; cured, sweet pickled stocks show decreases of 24.00% from last year and 12.67% from last month; and stocks in process of cure also show increases of 37.21% and 4.12% over last year and last month respectively.

The lard in storage amounts to 5,729,271 pounds, showing an increase of 5.62% over last year and a decrease of 4.08% from last month.

Beef stocks total 3,242,704 pounds of fresh frozen; 5,142,758 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 330,301 pounds of cured; and 184,907 pounds of stocks in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 46.29% over last year and 6.68% over last month; and fresh stocks not frozen show a decrease of 1.55% from last year and an increase of 42.78% over last month. Cured stocks show increases of 23.74% over last year and 12.81% over last month; and stocks in process of cure show an increase of 38.69% over last year and a decrease of 6.81% from last month.


The veal in storage amounts to 1,414,953 pounds of fresh frozen and 533,876 pounds of fresh not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show an increase of 102.45% over last year and a decrease of 1.34% from last month; and fresh stocks not frozen also show an increase of 7.55% over last year and a decrease of 4.03% from last month.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 392,383 pounds of frozen and 296,439 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show an increase of 19.96% over last year and a decrease of 39.56% from last month; and stocks not frozen show increases of 45.48% and 79.39% over last year and last month respectively.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 186,727 pounds; chickens 864,291 pounds; fowl 281,427 pounds; ducks 51,237 pounds; geese 35,546 pounds; turkeys 896,517 pounds; unclassified 212,906 pounds. Total poultry shows an increase of 23.04% over last year and a decrease of 16.87% from last month.

Fish stocks total 17,692,277 pounds of fresh frozen and 5,873,661 pounds of other fish in cold storage. Fresh frozen fish shows a decrease of 6.10% from last year and an increase of 9.30% over last month; and other fish in cold storage shows increases of 17.65% and 17.04% over last year and last month respectively.


During the month of July 3,660,432 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 4,860,648 pounds frozen during June.
