

COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS SEPTEMBER 1, 1929.

The butter in storage amounts to 25,506,956 pounds of creamery and 678,744 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows a decrease of 11.17% from last year and an increase of 22.78% over last month; while dairy butter shows increases of 10.33% over last year and 33.06% over last month.

Cheese stocks total 34,176,326 pounds, showing increases of 22.68% and 20.79% over last year and last month respectively.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 16,195,485 dozen; other than cold storage 752,773 dozen; and 3,396,250 pounds of frozen eggs. Cold storage eggs show increases of 6.67% over last year and 1.35% over last month; eggs, other than cold storage show decreases of 37.47% from last year and 55.69% from last month; while frozen eggs show a decrease of 1.71% from last year and an increase of 5.15% over last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 8,094,894 pounds; fresh, not frozen 2,531,906 pounds; cured dry salted 1,568,720 pounds; cured, sweet pickled 7,292,071 pounds; in process of cure 7,937,969 pounds. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 29.25% from last year and 20.64% from last month and fresh stocks not frozen also show decreases of 21.82% and 14.38% from last year and last month respectively. Cured, dry salted stocks show decreases of 53.38% from last year and 12.16% from last month; cured sweet pickled stocks also show decreases of 5.56% from last year and 9.11% from last month; and stocks in process of cure show an increase of 35.27% over last year and a decrease of 9.37% from last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 4,813,604 pounds showing an increase of 16.19% over last year and a decrease of 15.98% from last month.

Beef stocks total 4,042,238 pounds of fresh frozen; 4,427,936 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 393,963 pounds of cured; and 208,206 pounds of beef, in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 54.94% over last year and 24.92% over last month; while fresh stocks, not frozen show a decrease of 11.41% from last year and a decrease of 13.51% from last month. Cured stocks show increases of 32.19% over last year and 19.27% over last month; and stocks in process of cure also show increases of 20.39% and 12.60% over last year and last month respectively.


The veal in cold storage amounts to 1,701,672 pounds of fresh frozen and 457,171 pounds of fresh, not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 106.01% over last year and 21.62% over last month; while stocks not frozen show an increase of 23.15% over last year and a decrease of 14.82% from last month.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 399,047 pounds of frozen and 422,768 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show increases of 17.31% over last year and 1.97% over last month and stocks not frozen also show increases of 44.33% and 41.66% over last year and last month respectively.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 276,767 pounds; chickens 489,090 pounds; fowl 381,905 pounds; ducks 88,590 pounds; geese 27,502 pounds; turkeys 693,905 pounds; unclassified 303,726 pounds. Total poultry shows an increase of 57.19% over last year and a decrease of 10.89% from last month.

Fish stocks total 19,916,679 pounds of fresh frozen and 6,374,792 pounds of other fish in cold storage. Fresh frozen fish shows a decrease of 3.81% from last year and an increase of 11.92% over last month; while other fish in cold storage shows increases of 14.86% and 7.29% over last year and last month respectively.

During the month of August 5,632,611 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 5,660,432 pounds frozen during July.
