The butter in storage amounts to 13,517,959 pounds of creamery and 269,074 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows an increase of .70% over last year and a decrease of 24.10% from last month; and dairy butter shows decreases of 25.76% from last year and 8.29% from last month.

Cheese stocks total 12,082,235 pounds in store showing decreases of 34.56% and 14.96% from last year and last month respectively.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 862,349 dozen; other than cold storage 195,143 dozen; and frozen eggs 2,421,593 pounds. Decreases are shown in all egg stocks as follows:- Cold storage eggs 66.72% from last year and 80.33% from last month; other than cold storage eggs 27.05% from last year and 66.77% from last month; and frozen eggs 9.78% from last year and 12.56% from last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 11,231,638 pounds; fresh not frozen 2,971,421 pounds; cured dry salted 1,522,588 pounds; cured sweet pickled 6,065,694 pounds; in process of cure 6,920,127 pounds. Fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of 17.49% from last year and an increase of 63.42% over last month; fresh not frozen stocks show increases of 15.66% over last year and 1.96% over last month; cured dry salted stocks show a decrease of 28.94% from last year and an increase of 5.38% over last month; cured sweet pickled stocks show decreases of 3.00% from last year and 17.38% from last month; and stocks in process of cure show increases of 4.91% over last year and 5.92% over last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 2,855,828 pounds showing increases of .90% and 6.51% over last year and last month respectively.

Beef stocks total 19,205,139 pounds of fresh frozen; 4,525,401 pounds of fresh not frozen; 376,742 pounds of cured and 287,941 pounds of pork in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 18.25% over last year and 5.32% over last month; fresh not frozen stocks show an increase of 22.11% over last year and a decrease of 29.83% from last month; cured stocks show increases of 122.33% over last year and 73.69% over last month; and stocks in process of cure show a decrease of 13.74% from last year and an increase of 25.24% over last month.


The veal in cold storage amounts to 3,171,277 pounds of fresh frozen and 150,614 pounds of fresh not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 85.84% over last year and .90% over last month and stocks not frozen show an increase of 23.69% over last year and a decrease of 58.33% from last month.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 7,962,050 pounds of frozen and 299,644 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show increases of 38.81% over last year and 11.18% over last month; and stocks not frozen show an increase of 34.84% over last year and a decrease of 50.24% from last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 466,777 pounds, chickens 4,012,216 pounds; fowl 2,226,533 pounds; ducks 240,814 pounds; geese 169,910 pounds; turkeys 1,571,090 pounds; unclassified 3,052,815 pounds. Total poultry shows increases of 26.50% and 59.71% over last year and last month respectively.

Fish stocks total 29,673,942 pounds of fresh frozen and 5,861,851 pounds of other fish in cold storage. Fresh frozen fish shows an increase of 2.29% over last year and a decrease of 12.17% from last month; and other fish in cold storage shows decreases of 18.64% from last year and 7.43% from last month.


During the month of December 2,881,116 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 4,660,959 pounds frozen during November.
