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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, DECEMBER 1, 1930.

The butter in cold storage amounts to 28,727,948 pounds of creamery and 476,700 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows an increase of 61.14% over last year and a decrease of 14.74% from last month; and dairy butter also shows an increase of 61.70% over last year and a decrease of 9.60% from last month.

Cheese stocks total 16,914,627 pounds showing an increase of 19.06% over last year and a decrease of 31.77% from last month.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 7,978,730 dozen; other than cold storage 482,482 dozen; and frozen eggs 3,481,063 pounds. Cold storage eggs show an increase of 63.01% over last year and a decrease of 35.00% from last month; other than cold storage eggs show decreases of 17.89% from last year and 31.70% from last month; and frozen eggs show an increase of 25.70% over last year and a decrease of 17.23% from last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 3,768,920 pounds; fresh, not frozen 2,786,930 pounds; cured, dry salted 975,209 pounds; cured, sweet pickled 5,141,034 pounds; in process of cure 6,498,772 pounds. Fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of 48.94% from last year and an increase of 30.93% over last month; fresh stocks not frozen show a decrease of 5.00% over last year and an increase of 4.18% over last month; cured dry salted stocks show a decrease of 32.50% from last year and an increase of 9.58% over last month; cured sweet pickled stocks show a decrease of 29.97% from last year and an increase of 10.56% over last month; and stocks in process of cure also show a decrease of 1.47% over last year and an increase of 14.54% over last month.

The pure lard in storage amounts to 1,816,218 pounds showing a decrease of 32.36% from last year and an increase of 33.26% over last month.

Beef stocks total 6,701,198 pounds of fresh frozen; 4,547,219 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 199,903 pounds of cured and 130,568 pounds of beef in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of 63.31% from last year and an increase of 31.30% over last month; fresh stocks not frozen show decreases of 29.47% from last year and 8.62% from last month; cured stocks show decreases of 7.84% from last year and 34.89% from last month; and stocks in process of cure show a decrease of 43.21% from last year and an increase of 18.14% over last month.

The veal in cold storage amounts to 2,151,439 pounds of fresh frozen and 386,386 pounds of fresh not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of 31.67% from last year and an increase of 3.71% over last month; and fresh stocks not frozen show an increase of 6.54% over last year and a decrease of 48.10% from last month.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 6,801,303 pounds of frozen and 449,150 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show a decrease of 5.30% from last year and an increase of 64.60% over last month; and stocks not frozen show decreases of 25.41% from last year and 47.23% from last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 236,913 pounds; chickens 1,662,516 pounds; fowl 799,143 pounds; ducks 83,722 pounds; geese 136,329 pounds; turkeys 401,272 pounds; unclassified 974,519 pounds. Total poultry shows a decrease of 41.83% from last year and an increase of 56.91% over last month.

Fish stocks total 30,130,975 pounds of fresh frozen and 7,510,812 pounds of smoked and other varieties. Frozen stocks show increases of 21.21% over last year and .51% over last month and smoked and other varieties also show increases of 15.66% and 17.40% over last year and last month respectively.

During the month of November 3,721,263 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 3,988,761 pounds frozen during October.
