COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, June 1, 1930.

The butter in cold storage amounts to 10,798,828 pounds of creamery and 361,032 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows increases of 245.66% over last year and 31.90% over last month, and dairy butter also shows increases of 439.87% and 102.00% over last year and last month respectively.

Cheese stocks total 6,471,834 pounds showing a decrease of 38.43% from last year and an increase of 1.08% over last month.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 11,541,123 dozen; eggs, other than in cold storage 590,197 dozen; and frozen eggs 3,139,611 pounds. Cold storage eggs show a decrease of 6.11% from last year and an increase of 131.59% over last month; other than cold storage eggs show decreases of 41.12% from last year and 16.03% from last month; while frozen eggs show increases of 12.00% and 61.55% over last year and last month respectively.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 14,007,846 pounds; fresh not frozen 3,138,143 pounds; cured dry salted 2,129,954 pounds; cured sweet pickled 6,988,724 pounds; in process of cure 8,281,858 pounds. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 33.03% from last year and 4.13% from last month; fresh not frozen stocks show an increase of 19.21% over last year and a decrease of 7.33% from last month; cured dry salted stocks show a decrease 15.62% from last year and an increase of 65.82% over last month; cured sweet pickled stocks show a decrease of 23.04% from last year and an increase of 9.14% over last month; and stocks in process of cure also show a decrease of 9.64% from last year and an increase of 7.16% over last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 2,689,915 pounds showing a decrease of 49.66% from last year and an increase of 13.74% over last month.

Beef stocks total 7,298,744 pounds of fresh frozen; 4,031,143 pounds of fresh not frozen; 154,792 pounds of cured and 196,214 pounds of beef in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show an increase of 49.26% over last year and a decrease of 17.18% from last month; fresh not frozen stocks show a decrease of 1.68% from last year and an increase of 31.69% over last month; cured stocks show decreases of 58.00% from last year and 2.28% from last month; and stocks in process of cure show increases of 31.63% and 11.29% over last year and last month respectively.


The veal in cold storage amounts to 1,866,715 pounds of fresh frozen and 442,808 pounds of fresh not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 58.71% over last year and 20.51% over last month; and stocks fresh not frozen show decreases of 27.59% from last year and 18.37% from last month.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 2,909,658 pounds of frozen and 203,801 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show an increase of 121.17% over last year and a decrease of 36.08% from last month and stocks not frozen show decreases of 30.13% from last year and 16.61% from last month.

Stocks in poultry are as follows:- broilers 250,091 pounds; chickens 2,175,128 pounds, fowl 1,014,609 pounds, ducks 134,668 pounds, geese 100,939 pounds, turkeys 895,837 pounds, unclassified 1,144,437 pounds. Total poultry shows an increase of 47.46% over last year and a decrease of 24.14% from last month.

Fish stocks total 17,070,420 pounds of fresh frozen and 5,866,235 pounds of other fish in cold storage. Fresh frozen fish shows increases of 28.35% over last year and 5.25% over last month; and other fish in cold storage shows an increase of 32.29% over last year and a decrease of 7.11% from last month.

During the month of May 2,570,633 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 2,529,599 pounds frozen during April.



Statement of Food Commodities in storage on June 1, 1930 and a five year average as at June 1,


