COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, JULY 1, 1930.

The butter in cold storage amounts to 22,183,120 pounds of creamery and 616,808 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows increases of 97.40% over last year and 105.06% over last month and dairy butter also shows increases of 209.77% and 70.83% over last year and last month respectively.

Cheese stocks total 15,784,046 pounds, showing a decrease of 12.20% from last year and an increase of 144.00% over last month.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 14,595,909 dozen; other than in cold storage 742,690 dozen; and frozen eggs 4,068,291 pounds. Cold storage eggs show a decrease of 11.46% from last year and an increase of 27.58% over last month; other than cold storage eggs also show a decrease of 8.92% from last year and an increase of 26.48% over last month; while frozen eggs show increases of 16.90% and 29.58% over last year and last month respectively.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 13,019,599 pounds; fresh not frozen 2,513,053 pounds; cured dry salted 2,316,978 pounds; cured sweet pickled 9,850,078 pounds; and in process of cure 8,971,612 pounds. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 15.87% from last year and 7.07% from last month; fresh not frozen stocks also show decreases of 31.88% from last year and 19.90% from last month; cured dry salted stocks show increases of 33.71% over last year and 8.76% over last month; cured sweet pickled stocks show increases of 7.21% over last year and 40.93% over last month; and stocks in process of cure also show increases of 5.93% over last year and 8.33% over last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 3,492,389 pounds showing a decrease of 41.59% from last year and an increase of 30.55% over last month.

Beef stocks total 6,423,513 pounds of fresh frozen; 3,665,727 pounds of fresh not frozen; 345,389 pounds of cured; and 134,773 pounds of beef in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show an increase of 112.47% over last year and a decrease of 12.14% from last month; fresh stocks not frozen also show an increase of 1.64% over last year and a decrease of 8.86% from last month; cured stocks show increases of 17.93% over last year and 123.13% over last month; and stocks in process of cure show decreases of 32.08% and 31.40% from last year and last month respectively.


The veal in cold storage amounts to 2,127,817 pounds of fresh frozen and 286,743 pounds of fresh not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 47.37% over last year and 13.94% over last month; and fresh stocks not frozen show decreases of 48.46% from last year and 35.10% from last month.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 1,897,583 pounds of frozen and 242,846 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show an increase of 181.78% over last year and a decrease of 34.88% from last month; and stocks not frozen show increases of 46.96% over last year and 19.45% over last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 404,097 pounds; chickens 1,877,297 pounds; fowl 755,798 pounds; ducks 134,375 pounds; geese 87,990 pounds; turkeys 71,110 pounds; unclassified 1,123,964 pounds. Total poultry shows an increase of 67.66% over last year and a decrease of 10.60% from last month.

Fish stocks total 17,975,975 pounds of fresh frozen and 6,849,234 pounds of other fish in cold storage. Fresh frozen fish shows increases of 10.18% over last year and 1.78% over last month; and other fish in cold storage also show increases of 32.83% and 17.56% over last year and last month respectively.


During the month of June 5,319,601 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 2,570,633 pounds frozen during May.
