COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, AUGUST 1, 1930.

The butter in cold storage amounts to 32,643,390 pounds of creamery and 944,539 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows increases of 56.64% over last year and 47.15% over last month and dairy butter also shows increases of 154.37% over last year and 53.13% over last month.

Cheese stocks total 25,247,333 pounds, showing a decrease of 10.85% from last year and an increase of 59.94% over last month.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 15,811,596 dozen; other than cold storage 1,075,189 dozen; and frozen eggs 3,986,227 pounds. Cold storage eggs show a decrease of 3.40% from last year and an increase of 3.33% over last month; other than cold storage eggs also show a decrease of 26.38% from last year and an increase of 44.77% over last month; while frozen eggs show an increase of 23.42% over last year and a decrease of 2.02% from last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 8,768,759 pounds; fresh, not frozen 2,164,406 pounds; cured, dry salted 1,933,827 pounds; cured, sweet pickled 6,276,265 pounds; in process of cure 7,166,168 pounds. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 14.53% from last year and 32.65% from last month; fresh not frozen stocks show decreases of 27.23% from last year and 13.89% from last month; cured, dry salted stocks show an increase of 8.29% over last year and a decrease of 16.54% from last month; cured sweet pickled stocks show decreases of 21.74% from last year and 36.28% from last month; while stocks in process of cure also show decreases of 18.73% from last year and 20.12% from last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 3,196,075 pounds showing decreases of 44.22% and 9.11% from last year and last month, respectively.

Beef stocks total 5,320,139 pounds of fresh frozen; 3,940,055 pounds of fresh not frozen; 389,789 pounds of cured; and 191,171 pounds of beef in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show an increase of 64.06% over last year and a decrease of 17.18% from last month; fresh, not frozen stocks show a decrease of 23.41% from last year and an increase of 7.07% over last month; cured stocks show increases of 18.01% over last year and 12.86% over last month, and stocks in process of cure also show increases of 3.39% over last year and 41.85% over last month.


The veal in cold storage amounts to 2,019,420 pounds of fresh frozen and 381,722 pounds of fresh, not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show an increase of 42.72% over last year and a decrease of 5.09% from last month; while fresh stocks, not frozen, show a decrease of 28.50% from last year and an increase of 33.12% over last month.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 1,223,470 pounds of frozen and 276,576 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show an increase of 211.81% over last year and a decrease of 35.52% from last month; while stocks not frozen show a decrease of 6.73% from last year and an increase of 13.48% over last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 237,559 pounds; chickens 1,339,809 pounds; fowl 618,424 pounds; ducks 124,375 pounds; geese 86,488 pounds; turkeys 638,663 pounds; unclassified 867,867 pounds. Total poultry shows an increase of 51.33% over last year and a decrease of 25.19% from last month.

Fish stocks total 20,966,742 pounds of fresh frozen and 7,398,492 pounds of other fish in cold storage. Fresh frozen fish shows increases of 17.49% over last year and 15.78% over last month; while other fish in cold storage also shows increases of 19.56% and 9.15% over last year and last month, respectively.

During the month of July, 5,971,647 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 5,319,601 pounds frozen during June.


