COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, SEPTEMBER 1, 1930.

The butter in cold storage amounts to 39,570,168 pounds of creamery and 652,949 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows increases of 53.64% over last year and 21.49% over last month and dairy butter shows an increase of 20.44% over last year and a decrease of 30.83% from last month.

Cheese stocks total 30,975,401 pounds, showing a decrease of 9.43% from last year and an increase of 22.70% over last month.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 16,410,461 dozen; other than cold storage 1,072,833 dozen; and frozen eggs 3,965,893 pounds. Cold storage eggs show increases of 3.90% over last year and 3.76% over last month; other than cold storage eggs show an increase of 42.42% over last year and a decrease of .19% from last month; and frozen eggs show an increase of 16.77% over last year and a decrease of .51% from last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 6,767,533 pounds; fresh not frozen 1,863,197 pounds; cured dry salted 1,287,065 pounds; cured, sweet pickled 5,567,919 pounds; in process of cure 5,936,719 pounds. Comparative figures show decreases in all stocks of pork as follows:- fresh frozen 16.40% from last year and 22.26% from last month; fresh not frozen 26.60% from last year and 12.71% from last month; cured, dry salted stocks 17.99% from last year and 33.44% from last month; cured, sweet pickled 23.64% from last year and 11.29% from last month; and in process of cure 24.58% from last year and 15.57% from last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 2,290,235 pounds showing decreases of 52.51% and 31.61% from last year and last month respectively.

Beef stocks total 4,480,919 pounds of fresh frozen; 3,900,529 pounds of fresh not frozen; 310,721 pounds of cured; and 90,262 pounds of stocks in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show an increase of 10.85% over last year and a decrease of 15.55% from last month; fresh stocks not frozen show decreases of 12.62% from last year and .97% from last month; cured stocks show decreases of 21.13% from last year and 20.28% from last month; and stocks in process of cure also show decreases of 56.65% and 52.78% from last year and last month respectively.


The veal in cold storage amounts to 1,585,222 pounds of fresh frozen and 470,623 pounds of fresh, not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 7.51% from last year and 21.02% from last month; while fresh stocks not frozen show increases of 2.94% over last year and 25.26% over last month.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 824,653 pounds of frozen and 336,958 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show an increase of 106.66% over last year and a decrease of 33.30% from last month, and stocks not frozen show a decrease of 20.38% from last year and an increase of 21.83% over last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 228,954 pounds; chickens 984,291 pounds; fowl 394,792 pounds; ducks 114,813 pounds; geese 55,608 pounds; turkeys 502,999 pounds; unclassified 792,323 pounds. Total poultry shows an increase of 35.14% over last year and a decrease of 21.39% from last month.

Fish stocks total 28,327,169 pounds of frozen fish and 7,026,288 pounds of smoked and other varieties. Frozen stocks show increases of 42.23% over last year and 35.55% over last month and smoked and other varieties show an increase of 10.22% over last year and a decrease of 6.33% from last month.


During the month of August 5,271,776 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 5,971,647 pounds frozen during July.
