COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, JANUARY 1, 1931.

The butter in cold storage amounts to 21,664,979 pounds of creamery and 506,234 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows an increase of 61.43% over last year and a decrease of 24.78% from last month; while dairy butter shows increases of 88.14% over last year and 6.20% over last month.

Cheese stocks total 16,529,556 pounds showing an increase of 36.88% over last year and a decrease of 2.28% from last month.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 4,691,950 dozen; other than cold storage 647,790 dozen; and frozen eggs 3,303,367 pounds. Cold storage eggs show an increase of 444.09% over last year and a decrease of 41.75% from last month; other than cold storage eggs show increases of 229.42% over last year and 34.26% over last month; and frozen eggs show an increase of 36.41% over last year and a decrease of 5.10% from last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 5,978,502 pounds; fresh not frozen 2,247,788 pounds; cured, dry salted 935,274 pounds; cured, sweet pickled 5,713,283 pounds; in process of cure 4,712,358 pounds. Fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of 44.24% from last year and an increase of 58.63% over last month; fresh stocks not frozen show decreases of 24.98% from last year and 19.35% from last month; cured dry salted stocks show decreases of 35.48% from last year and 4.10% from last month; cured, sweet pickled stocks show a decrease of 4.66% from last year and an increase of 11.13% over last month; and stocks in process of cure show decreases of 31.76% and 27.49% from last year and last month respectively.

The pure lard in storage amounts to 2,093,899 pounds showing a decrease of 26.88% from last year and an increase of 15.29% over last month.

Beef stocks total 7,409,603 pounds of fresh frozen; 3,418,992 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 228,054 pounds of cured and 168,525 pounds of beef in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of 59.29% from last year and an increase of 10.57% over last month; fresh stocks not frozen show decreases of 18.32% from last year and 24.81% from last month; cured stocks show a decrease of 39.47% from last year and an increase of 14.08% over last month; and stocks in process of cure show decreases of 41.47% from last year and an increase of 29.07% over last month.

The veal in cold storage amounts to 1,957,618 pounds of fresh frozen and 197,566 pounds of fresh not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 36.63% from last year and 9.01% from last month; and fresh stocks not frozen show an increase of 31.17% over last year and a decrease of 48.37% from last month.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 6,730,756 pounds of frozen and 258,460 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show decreases of 19.40% from last year and 1.13% from last month; and stocks not frozen also show decreases of 13.74% and 42.46% from last year and last month respectively.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 273,197 pounds; chickens 2,690,755 pounds; fowl 956,536 pounds; ducks 69,626 pounds; geese 117,141 pounds; turkeys 1,110,174 pounds; unclassified 2,333,087 pounds. Total poultry shows a decrease of 34.97% from last year and an increase of 75.63% over last month.

Fish stocks total 23,830,908 pounds of fresh frozen and 6,877,386 pounds of smoked and other varieties. Fresh frozen stocks show an increase of 15.27% over last year and a decrease of 21.35% from last month; and smoked and other varieties also show an increase of 17.32% over last year and a decrease of 8.43% from last month.

During the month of December 1,932,074 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 3,721,263 pounds frozen during November.

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
