COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, November 1, 1931.

The butter in cold storage amounts to 37,299,113 pounds of creamery and 390,169 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows an increase of 10.15% over last year and a decrease of 8.26% from last month and dairy butter shows decreases of 26.01% from last year and 7.01% from last month.

Cheese stocks total 14,296,818 pounds in storage showing decreases of 42.35% and 32.19% from last year and last month respectively.

Cold storage eggs amount to 9,553,635 dozen; fresh eggs 425,443 dozen; and frozen eggs 5,144,261 pounds. Cold storage eggs show decreases of 22.24% from last year and 29.91% from last month; fresh eggs also show decreases of 39.77% from last year and 50.78% from last month; and frozen eggs show an increase of 20.88% over last year and a decrease of 1.60% from last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 4,356,454 pounds; fresh not frozen 3,086,988 pounds; cured dry salted 977,177 pounds; cured sweet pickled 6,170,875 pounds; in process of cure 6,632,946 pounds. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 51.35% over last year and 6.03% over last month and fresh not frozen stocks also show increases of 15.40% over last year and 18.88% over last month. Cured dry salted stocks show an increase of 9.80% over last year and a decrease of 7.16% from last month; cured sweet pickled stocks show increases of 32.71% over last year and 12.52% over last month; and stocks in process of cure also show increases of 16.91% and 13.77% over last year and last month respectively.

The pure lard in storage amounts to 1,381,626 pounds showing an increase of 1.37% over last year and a decrease of 47.42% from last month.

Beef stocks total 2,983,142 pounds of fresh frozen; 4,805,154 pounds of fresh not frozen; 90,710 pounds of cured; and 104,688 pounds of beef in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of 41.72% from last year and an increase of 5.72% over last month; fresh stocks not frozen also show a decrease of 3.43% from last year and an increase of 5.80% over last month; cured stocks show decreases of 70.45% from last year and 38.22% from last month; and stocks in process of cure also show decreases of 5.28% from last year and 20.97% from last month.

The veal in storage amounts to 1,203,274 pounds of fresh frozen and 492,897 pounds of fresh not frozen. Frozen stocks show decreases of 41.99% from last year and .92% from last month and fresh stocks not frozen show a decrease of 33.79% from last year and an increase of 32.81% over last month.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 6,133,077 pounds of frozen and 657,462 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show increases of 48.06% over last year and 304.94% over last month and stocks not frozen show a decrease of 22.76% from last year and an increase of 28.97% over last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 245,223 pounds; chickens 984,744 pounds; fowl 787,003 pounds; ducks 59,155 pounds; geese 32,043 pounds, turkeys 48,675 pounds; unclassified 1,057,768 pounds. Total poultry shows increases of 15.21% and 60.97% over last year and last month respectively.

Fish stocks total 20,955,044 pounds of fresh frozen and 8,888,990 pounds of smoked and other varieties. Fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of 30.71% from last year and an increase of 4.86% over last month and smoked and other varieties show an increase of 38.94% over last year and a decrease of 16.92% from last month.

During the month of October 3,953,888 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 2,653,429 pounds frozen during September.

Fresh unfrozen fish in storage amounts to 1,092,840 pounds as compared with 99,541 pounds shown last month.

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




