COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, DECEMBER 1, 1931.

The butter in cold storage amounts to 1,368,165 pounds of creamery and 287,692 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows an increase of 9.19% over last year and a decrease of 15.85% from last month and dairy butter shows decreases of 39.67% from last year and 15.80% from last month.

Cheese stocks total 12,640,192 pounds in storage, showing decreases of 25.27% and 11.58% from last year and last month, respectively.

Cold storage eggs amount to 5,654,380 dozen; fresh eggs 297,373 dozen, and frozen eggs 4,553,995 pounds. Cold storage eggs show decreases of 29.13% from last year and 40.69% from last month; fresh eggs also show decreases of 38.38% from last year and 30.10% from last month, and frozen eggs show an increase of 29.43% over last year and a decrease of 11.47% from last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 7,798,688 pounds; fresh, not frozen 3,567,033 pounds; cured, dry salted 1,199,450 pounds; cured, sweet pickled 7,156,227 pounds; in process of cure 6,158,119 pounds. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 106.92% over last year and 80.82% over last month; fresh stocks, not frozen increased 27.97% over last year and 17.84% over last month; cured, dry salted stocks increased 22.99% over last year and 22.75% over last month; and cured, sweet pickled stocks also show increases of 39.19% over last year and 15.97% over last month. Stocks in process of cure show decreases of 5.24% from last year and 6.57% from last month.

The pure lard in storage amounts to 1,942,020 pounds, showing increases of 6.92% and 41.43% over last year and last month, respectively.

Beef stocks total 4,180,115 pounds of fresh frozen; 5,254,621 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 120,446 pounds of cured; and 113,325 pounds of beef in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of 37.62% from last year and an increase of 41.60% over last month; fresh stocks, not frozen show increases of 15.54% over last year and 9.58% over last month; cured stocks show a decrease of 39.79% from last year and an increase of 32.70% over last month; and stocks in process of cure also show a decrease of 13.21% from last year and an increase of 8.25% over last month.

The veal in storage amounts to 1,209,579 pounds of fresh frozen and 354,123 pounds of fresh not frozen. Frozen stocks show a decrease of 43.78% from last year and an increase of 3.14% over last month; and fresh stocks not frozen show decreases of 8.35% from last year and 27.34% from last month.


Mutton and lamb stocks total 7,649,964 pounds of frozen and 566,507 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show increases of 12.48% over last year and 24.91% over last month; and stocks not frozen show an increase of 26.08% over last year and a decrease of 13.83% from last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 390,730 pounds; chickens 2,683,383 pounds; fowl 1,144,934 pounds; ducks 137,168 pounds; geese 244,936 pounds; turkeys 445,206 pounds; unclassified 1,882,898 pounds. Total poultry shows increases of 61.33% and 115.63% over last year and last month, respectively.

Fish stocks total 19,503,501 pounds of fresh frozen and 9,563,129 pounds of smoked and other varieties. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 35.27% from last year and 9.84% from last month, and smoked and other varieties show increases of 27.32% over last year and 7.25% over last month.

During the month of November, 2,257,718 pounds of fish were frozen, as compared with 3,953,888 pounds frozen during October.


Fresh unfrozen fish in storage amounts to 57,085 pounds, as compared with 1,092,840 pounds shown last month.
