COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, FEBRUARY 1, 1931.

The butter in cold storage amounts to 16,886,579 pounds of creamery and 392,870 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows an increase of 23.68% over last year and a decrease of 22.16% from last month, and dairy butter also shows an increase of 41.07% over last year and a decrease of 21.59% from last month.

Cheese stocks total 14,638,710 pounds showing an increase of 41.89% over last year and a decrease of 11.44% from last month.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 3,151,134 dozen; other than cold storage 511,162 dozen; and frozen eggs 3,350,343 pounds. Cold storage eggs show an increase of 1,323.63% over last year and a decrease of 34.47% from last month; other than cold storage eggs show an increase of 222.07% over last year and a decrease of 21.07% from last month; and frozen eggs show increases of 40.15% and 1.16% over last year and last month respectively.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 6,284,430 pounds; fresh, not frozen 2,978,513 pounds; cured dry salted 994,644 pounds; cured sweet pickled 5,538,289 pounds; in process of cure 5,370,180 pounds. Fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of 53.23% from last year and an increase of 5.13% over last month; fresh stocks not frozen show a decrease of 21.82% from last year and an increase of 32.51% over last month; cured dry salted stocks show a decrease of 23.16% from last year and an increase of 6.35% over last month; cured sweet pickled stocks show decreases of 13.61% from last year and 3.06% from last month; and stocks in process of cure show a decrease of 23.68% from last year and an increase of 13.96% over last month.

The pure lard in storage amounts to 2,841,864 pounds, showing a decrease of 1.36% from last year and an increase of 35.72% over last month.

Beef stocks total 5,723,959 pounds of fresh frozen; 4,798,655 pounds of fresh not frozen; 197,883 pounds of cured and 154,162 pounds of beef in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 60.18% from last year and 22.69% from last month; fresh stocks not frozen show a decrease of 9.29% from last year and an increase of 40.35% over last month; cured stocks show decreases of 23.07% from last year and 13.23% from last month; and stocks in process of cure also show decreases of 47.15% from last year and 2.52% from last month.

The veal in cold storage amounts to 1,074,131 pounds of fresh frozen and 321,290 pounds of fresh not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 53.83% from last year and 45.12% from last month; while fresh stocks not frozen show increases of 20.79% over last year and 62.62% over last month.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 4,597,129 pounds of frozen and 720,385 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show decreases of 35.25% from last year and 31.43% from last month; while stocks not frozen show increases of 21.25% over last year and 178.92% over last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 221,385 pounds; chickens 2,713,626 pounds; fowl 878,107 pounds; ducks 79,089 pounds; geese 47,863 pounds; turkeys 848,591 pounds; unclassified 2,100,757 pounds. Total poultry shows decreases of 35.04% and 8.69% from last year and last month respectively.

Fish stocks total 22,497,037 pounds of fresh frozen and 6,781,155 pounds of smoked and other varieties. Fresh frozen stocks show an increase of 23.08% over last year and a decrease of 5.40% from last month; and smoked and other varieties also show an increase of 12.20% over last year and a decrease of 6.95% from last month.

During the month of January 1,295,415 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 1,932,074 pounds frozen during December.

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
