COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, MARCH 1, 1931.

The butter in cold storage amounts to 11,272,920 pounds of creamery and 222,365 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows decreases of 13.86% from last year and 33.39% from last month and dairy butter shows an increase of 39.72% over last year and a decrease of 28.14% from last month.

Cheese stocks total 13,203,406 pounds showing an increase of 49.03% over last year and a decrease of 9.82% from last month.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 1,195,005 dozen; other than cold storage 553,650 dozen; and frozen eggs 2,885,413 pounds. Cold storage eggs show an increase of 1,588.17% over last year and a decrease of 62.05% from last month; eggs other than cold storage show increases of 82.90% over last year and 8.81% over last month; and frozen eggs show an increase of 46.74% over last year and a decrease of 13.88% from last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 8,014,271 pounds; fresh not frozen 3,204,447 pounds; cured, dry salted 848,348 pounds; cured sweet pickled 6,791,096 pounds; in process of cure 5,990,746 pounds. Fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of 45.53% from last year and an increase of 27.26% over last month; fresh stocks not frozen show increases of 7.72% over last year and 7.73% over last month; cured dry salted stocks show decreases of 33.32% from last year and 14.13% from last month; cured sweet pickled stocks show a decrease of 3.81% from last year and an increase of 23.23% over last month; and stocks in process of cure show a decrease of 24.89% from last year and an increase of 11.56% over last month.

The pure lard in storage amounts to 3,225,136 pounds showing increases of 21.19% and 14.32% over last year and last month respectively.

Beef stocks total 5,022,192 pounds of fresh frozen and 3,995,576 pounds of fresh not frozen; cured stocks 315,867 pounds & stocks in process of cure 146,462. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 54.42% from last year and 12.47% from last month; and fresh stocks not frozen also show decreases of 15.08% from last year and 16.61% from last month. Cured stocks show increases of 14.32% over last year and 59.52% over last month; and stocks in process of cure show decreases of 41.48% from last year and 4.99% from last month.

The veal in cold storage amounts to 793,697 pounds of fresh frozen and 266,848 pounds of fresh not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 49.78% from last year and 25.14% from last month; and fresh stocks not frozen also show decreases of 8.73% and 17.15% from last year and last month respectively.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 4,298,156 pounds of frozen and 182,661 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show decreases of 13.39% from last year and 15.51% from last month; and stocks not frozen also show decreases of 46.35% from last year and 27.84% from last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 175,151 pounds; chickens 2,597,886 pounds; fowl 943,313 pounds; ducks 77,186 pounds; geese 44,001 pounds; turkeys 781,231 pounds; unclassified 1,750,868 pounds. Total poultry shows decreases of 35.07% and 7.63% from last year and last month respectively.

Fish stocks total 21,034,714 pounds of fresh frozen and 4,861,754 pounds of smoked and other varieties. Fresh frozen stocks show an increase of 12.31% over last year and a decrease of 7.08% from last month; and smoked and other varieties show decreases of 22.25% from last year and 30.11% from last month.

During the month of February 3,161,806 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 1,295,415 pounds frozen during January.

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
