COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, MAY 1, 1931.

The butter in cold storage amounts to 5,121,758 pounds of creamery and 138,164 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows decreases of 37.95% from last year and 22.15% from last month; and dairy butter also shows decreases of 28.39% and 31.77% from last year and last month respectively.

Cheese stocks total 10,379,102 pounds showing an increase of 61.98% over last year and a decrease of 11.99% from last month.

Cold storage eggs amount to 5,656,294 dozen; fresh eggs 1,621,119 dozen; and frozen eggs 3,747,898 pounds. Cold storage eggs show increases of 13.35% over last year and 200.97% over last month; fresh eggs show increases of 130.27% over last year and 91.87% over last month; and frozen eggs also show increases of 76.78% and 14.51% over last year and last month respectively.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 8,383,203 pounds; fresh, not frozen 3,143,401 pounds; cured dry salted 1,095,168 pounds; cured sweet pickled 6,379,943 pounds; in process of cure 5,956,580 pounds. Decreases from last year were shown in all grades as follows:- fresh frozen 43.64%; fresh, not frozen 10.49%; cured dry salted 27.62%; sweet pickled 3.80%; in process of cure 25.13%. Compared with last month's figures there were increases in all grades as follows:- fresh frozen 13.28%; fresh, not frozen 9.13%; cured dry salted 5.55%; sweet pickled 3.92%; in process of cure 8.74%.

The pure lard in storage amounted to 3,964,820 pounds showing increases of 61.15% and 25.25% over last year and last month respectively.

Beef stocks total 3,888,763 pounds of fresh frozen; 3,321,134 pounds of fresh not frozen; 223,565 pounds of cured; and 102,872 pounds of beef in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 57.73% from last year and 16.30% from last month; fresh stocks unfrozen show an increase of .99% over last year and a decrease of 12.21% from last month; cured stocks show an increase of 41.14% over last year and a decrease of 15.63% from last month; and stocks in process of cure show decreases of 41.65% from last year and 29.38% from last month.

The veal in cold storage amounts to 845,599 pounds of frozen and 475,839 pounds of fresh unfrozen. Fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of 46.10% from last year and an increase of 40.99% over last month; and fresh unfrozen stocks also show a decrease of 17.83% from last year and an increase of 63.81% over last month.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 1,904,621 pounds of frozen and 144,237 pounds of fresh unfrozen. Frozen stocks show decreases of 59.71% from last year and 33.69% from last month; and stocks not frozen also show decreases of 42.84% from last year and 46.74% from last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 73,862 pounds; chickens 1,261,410 pounds; fowl 631,659 pounds; ducks 56,093 pounds; geese 32,090 pounds; turkeys 478,910 pounds; unclassified 749,940 pounds. Total poultry shows decreases of 56.57% and 33.29% from last year and last month respectively.

Fish stocks total 15,040,426 pounds of fresh frozen and 4,758,312 pounds of smoked and other varieties. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 10.07% from last year and 18.08% from last month; and smoked and other varieties also show decreases of 24.68% and 16.55% from last year and last month respectively.

During the month of April 1,126,862 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 531,886 pounds frozen during March.






