

COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, JUNE 1, 1931.

The butter in cold storage amounts to 8,544,013 pounds of creamery and 151,516 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows a decrease of 20.91% from last year and an increase of 66.74% from last month; and dairy butter shows a decrease of 58.03% from last year and an increase of 10.43% over last month.

The cheese stocks total 10,634,074 pounds showing increases of 64.31% and 2.46% over last year and last month respectively.

Cold storage eggs amount to 11,719,130 dozen; fresh eggs 1,378,080 dozen; and frozen eggs 5,469,637 pounds. Cold storage eggs show increases of 1.46% over last year and 107.20% over last month; fresh eggs show an increase of 133.49% over last year and a decrease of 14.66% from last month; and frozen eggs show increases of 64.96% over last year and 45.99% over last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 7,802,337 pounds; fresh not frozen 2,987,431 pounds; cured dry salted 877,393 pounds; cured sweet pickled 6,402,285 pounds; in process of cure 6,075,630 pounds. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 44.30% from last year and 7.06% from last month; fresh not frozen stocks show decreases of 4.80% from last year and 4.94% from last month; cured dry salted stocks show decreases of 58.81% from last year and 19.88% from last month; cured sweet pickled stocks show a decrease of 8.33% from last year and an increase of .38% over last month; and stocks in process of cure show a decrease of 26.64% from last year and an increase of 2.00% over last month.

The pure lard in storage amounts to 4,379,503 pounds showing increases of 62.81% and 10.50% over last year and last month respectively.

Beef stocks total 3,679,482 pounds of fresh frozen; 4,520,576 pounds of fresh not frozen; 177,373 pounds of cured; and 168,622 pounds of beef in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 49.63% from last year and 5.74% from last month; fresh stocks not frozen show increases of 12.14% over last year and 37.26% over last month; cured stocks show an increase of 14.59% over last year and a decrease of 20.29% from last month; and stocks in process of cure show a decrease of 14.06% from last year and an increase of 63.91% over last month.

The veal in cold storage amounts to 1,209,792 pounds of fresh frozen and 573,721 pounds of fresh not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of 35.19% from last year and an increase of 41.60% over last month; and fresh stocks not frozen show increases of 29.56% over last year and 22.08% over last month.


Mutton and lamb stocks total 947,924 pounds of frozen and 131,953 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show decreases of 67.49% from last year and 50.38% from last month and stocks not frozen also show decreases of 35.35% from last year and 6.01% from last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 64,195 pounds; chickens 854,077 pounds fowl 495,002 pounds; ducks 49,911 pounds; geese 32,111 pounds; turkeys 386,060 pounds; unclassified 521,170 pounds. Total poultry shows decreases of 57.93% and 26.20% from last year and last month respectively.

Fish stocks total 15,075,462 pounds of fresh frozen and 4,368,217 pounds of smoked and other varieties. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 12.63% from last year and 1.57% from last month and smoked and other varieties also show decreases of 25.55% from last year and 3.20% from last month.

Fresh unfrozen fish in storage amounts to 101,799 pounds while 52,788 pounds were shown last month.


During the month of May 2,560,429 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 1,123,862 pounds frozen during April.
