COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, JULY 1, 1931.

The butter in cold storage amounts to 20,664,166 pounds of creamery and 267,925 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows a decrease of 6.94% from last year and an increase of 141.77% over last month; and dairy butter also shows a decrease of 56.56% from last year and an increase of 78.10% over last month.

Cheese stocks total 19,039,355 pounds in storage showing increases of 30.62% and 79.61% over last year and last month respectively.

Cold storage eggs amount to 13,877,142 dozen; fresh eggs 940,301 dozen; and frozen eggs 5,360,498 pounds. Cold storage eggs show a decrease of 5.79% from last year and an increase of 14.88% over last month; fresh eggs show an increase of 25.99% over last year and a decrease of 8.27% from last month; and frozen eggs also show an increase of 25.61% over last year and a decrease of 2.02% from last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 6,472,837 pounds; fresh, not frozen 2,608,818 pounds; cured dry salted 1,206,668 pounds; cured sweet pickled 5,509,281 pounds; in process of cure 5,631,695 pounds. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 50.28% from last year and 16.91% from last month; fresh stocks not frozen show an increase of 3.81% over last year and a decrease of 10.96% from last month; cured dry salted stocks show a decrease of 47.92% from last year and an increase of 40.62% over last month; cured sweet pickled stocks show decreases of 44.07% from last year and 11.72% from last month; and stocks in process of cure show decreases of 37.23% and 4.77% from last year and last month respectively.

The pure lard in storage amounts to 3,981,175 pounds showing an increase of 14.00% over last year and a decrease of 8.67% from last month.

Beef stocks total 3,130,412 pounds of fresh frozen; 4,320,605 pounds of fresh not frozen; 157,496 pounds of cured; and 186,453 pounds of beef in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 51.34% from last year and 14.83% from last month; fresh stocks not frozen show an increase of 17.86% over last year and a decrease of 5.07% from last month; cured stocks show decreases of 54.40% from last year and 11.21% from last month; and stocks in process of cure show increases of 38.35% over last year and 10.57% over last month.

The veal in cold storage amounts to 1,221,692 pounds of fresh frozen and 504,629 pounds of fresh not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of 42.58% from last year and an increase of .72% over last month; and fresh stocks not frozen show an increase of 75.99% over last year and a decrease of 11.63% from last month.


Mutton and lamb stocks total 606,608 pounds of frozen and 246,018 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show decreases of 68.23% from last year and 35.82% from last month; and stocks not frozen show increases of 1.31% over last year and 82.97% over last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 80,343 pounds; chickens 513,892 pounds; fowl 426,081 pounds; ducks 36,769 pounds; geese 47,977 pounds; turkeys 273,959 pounds; unclassified 432,306 pounds. Total poultry shows decreases of 64.59% and 25.13% from last year and last month respectively.

Fish stocks total 15,365,474 pounds of fresh frozen and 4,847,627 pounds of smoked and other varieties. Fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of 15.58% from last year and an increase of 3.79% over last month; and smoked and other varieties also show a decrease of 29.24% from last year and an increase of 10.97% over last month.

Fresh unfrozen fish in storage amounts to 106,241 pounds as compared with 101,799 shown last month.

During the month of June 2,929,559 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 2,560,429 pounds frozen during May.


