COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, August 1, 1931.

The butter in cold storage amounts to 32,747,870 pounds of creamery and 415,421 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows increases of .27% over last year and 59.18% over last month; and dairy butter shows a decrease of 56.02% from last year and an increase of 39.53% over last month.

Cheese stocks total 25,245,175 pounds in storage showing a decrease of .01% from last year and an increase of 32.49% over last month.

Cold storage eggs amount to 14,354,464 dozen; fresh eggs 837,987 dozen; and frozen eggs 5,438,410 pounds. Cold storage eggs show a decrease of 9.98% from last year and an increase of 3.40% over last month; fresh eggs show decreases of 22.28% from last year and 10.56% from last month; while frozen eggs show increases of 28.74% and 1.49% over last year and last month respectively.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 6,162,935 pounds; fresh not frozen 2,412,590 pounds; cured dry salted 950,111 pounds; cured sweet pickled 5,112,859 pounds; in process of cure 5,790,359 pounds. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 29.72% from last year and 7.30% from last month; fresh not frozen stocks show an increase of 11.47% over last year and a decrease of 10.97% from last month; cured dry salted stocks show decreases of 50.87% from last year and 22.47% from last month; cured, sweet pickled show decreases of 18.54% from last year and 17.72% from last month; and stocks in process of cure also show decreases of 19.20% from last year and .24% from last month.

The pure lard in storage amounts to 4,179,326 pounds showing increases of 22.17% and 2.48% over last year and last month respectively.

Beef stocks total 2,831,435 pounds of fresh frozen; 3,665,815 pounds of fresh not frozen; 170,218 pounds of cured; and 184,728 pounds of beef in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 46.84% from last year and 9.31% from last month; fresh not frozen stocks show decreases of 6.96% from last year and 13.62% from last month; cured stocks show a decrease of 56.33% from last year and an increase of 8.86% over last month; and stocks in process of cure show decreases of 3.37% from last year and .93% from last month.

The veal in cold storage amounts to 1,226,416 pounds of fresh frozen and 384,425 pounds of fresh not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of 39.27% from last year and an increase of 1.57% over last month; and fresh not frozen stocks show an increase of .71% over last year and a decrease of 23.24% from last month.


Mutton and lamb stocks total 495,802 pounds of frozen and 275,901 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show decreases of 59.99% from last year and 18.09% from last month; and stocks not frozen show a decrease of .24% from last year and an increase of 16.89% over last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 127,643 pounds; chickens 423,519 pounds; fowl 411,173 pounds; ducks 46,247 pounds; geese 25,924 pounds; turkeys 234,497 pounds; unclassified 452,058 pounds. Total poultry show decreases of 56.02% and 4.15% from last year and last month respectively.

Fish stocks total 19,593,861 pounds of fresh frozen and 5,217,663 pounds of smoked and other varieties. Fresh frozen fish shows a decrease of 7.11% from last year and an increase of 24.28% over last month; and smoked and other varieties also shows a decrease of 29.48% from last year and an increase of 7.62% over last month.

During the month of July 3,582,319 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 2,929,559 pounds frozen during June.


Fresh unfrozen fish in storage amounts to 58,291 pounds as compared with 101,799 pounds shown last month.
