COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, SEPTEMBER 1, 1931.

The butter in cold storage amounts to 39,945,339 pounds of creamery and 369,409 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows increases of .95% over last year and 21.79% over last month; and dairy butter shows decreases of 43.45% from last year and 1.48% from last month.

Cheese stocks total 29,829,082 pounds in storage showing a decrease of 3.70% from last year and an increase of 17.98% over last month.

Cold storage eggs amount to 14,373,752 dozen; fresh eggs 1,363,241 dozen, and frozen eggs 5,438,803 pounds. Cold storage eggs show a decrease of 12.41% from last year and an increase of .17% over last month; fresh eggs show increases of 27.07% and 60.61% over last year and last month respectively; and frozen eggs show an increase of 29.37 over last year and a decrease of .20% from last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 4,916,858 pounds; fresh, not frozen 2,790,900 pounds; cured dry salted 736,011 pounds; cured sweet pickled 6,757,535 pounds; in process of cure 5,244,618 pounds. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 27.98% from last year and 19.39% from last month and fresh stocks not frozen show increases of 47.65% over last year and 16.42% over last month. Cured dry salted stocks show decreases of 42.81% from last year and 22.56% from last month; cured sweet pickled stocks show increases of 21.18% over last year and 32.07% over last month; and stocks in process of cure show decreases of 13.34% and 8.50% from last year and last month respectively.

The pure lard in storage amounts to 3,208,067 pounds showing an increase of 34.22% over last year and a decrease of 23.36% from last month.

Beef stocks total 2,633,684 pounds of fresh frozen; 4,710,804 pounds of fresh not frozen; 191,617 pounds of cured; and 174,505 pounds of beef in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 41.42% from last year and 6.62% from last month; fresh not frozen stocks show increases of 20.68% over last year and 23.63% over last month; cured dry salted stocks show a decrease of 38.33% from last year and an increase of 12.45% over last month; and stocks in process of cure show an increase of 93.33% over last year and a decrease of 4.23% from last month.

The veal in storage amounts to 1,232,808 pounds of fresh frozen and 288,580 pounds of fresh not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of 19.73% from last year and an increase of 3.20% over last month, and fresh stocks not frozen show decreases of 39.58% from last year and 25.50% from last month.


Mutton and lamb stocks total 525,595 pounds of frozen and 262,455 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show a decrease of 36.26% from last year and an increase of 3.89% over last month; and stocks not frozen show decreases of 22.11% from last year and 4.32% from last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 242,662 pounds; chickens 238,971 pounds; fowl 382,069 pounds; ducks 29,961 pounds; geese 24,701 pounds; turkeys 106,971 pounds; unclassified 591,969 pounds. Total poultry shows decreases of 47.39% and 3.69% from last year and last month respectively.

Fish stocks total 20,167,857 pounds of fresh frozen and 4,584,780 pounds of smoked and other varieties. Fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of 28.80% from last year and an increase of 13.38% over last month; and smoked and other varieties show decreases of 34.75% and 12.13% from last year and last month respectively.

During the month of August 3,461,654 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 3,582,319 pounds frozen during July.

Fresh unfrozen fish in storage amounts to 56,841 pounds as compared with 58,291 pounds shown last month.
