COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, JANUARY 1, 1932.

The butter in cold storage amounts to 23,936,618 pounds of creamery and 215,838 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows an increase of 10.49% over last year and a decrease of 23.09% from last month and dairy butter shows decreases of 57.36% from last year and 22.21% from last month.

Cheese stocks total 11,664,318 pounds showing decreases of 29.43% and 7.73% from last year and last month respectively.

Cold Storage eggs amount to 2,862,080 dozen; fresh eggs 510,023 dozen, and frozen eggs 4,160,069 pounds. Cold Storage eggs show decreases of 38.59% from last year and 50.18% from last month; fresh eggs show a decrease of 22.50% from last year and an increase of 71.51% over last month; and frozen eggs show an increase of 24.61% over last year and a decrease of 8.66% from last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 14,891,579 pounds; fresh, not frozen 2,658,544 pounds; cured dry salted 438,873 pounds; cured sweet pickled 6,705,398 pounds; in process of cure 5,580,246 pounds. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 149.09% over last year and 85.77% over last month; fresh stocks not frozen show an increase of 18.27% over last year and a decrease of 21.91% from last month; cured dry salted stocks show decreases of 53.08% from last year and 63.33% from last month; cured sweet pickled stocks show an increase of 17.37% over last year and a decrease of 7.09% from last month; and stocks in process of cure also show an increase of 18.42% over last year and a decrease of 9.13% from last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 2,481,609 pounds showing increases of 18.52% and 47.08% over last year and last month respectively.

Beef stocks total 6,167,164 pounds of fresh frozen, 3,502,095 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 184,704 pounds of cured and 169,434 pounds of beef in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of 16.77% from last year and an increase of 48.97% over last month; fresh, not frozen stocks show an increase of 2.43% over last year and a decrease of 33.13% from last month; cured stocks show a decrease of 19.01% from last year and an increase of 51.78% over last month, and stocks in process of cure, show increases of .54% over last year and 55.89% over last month.


The veal in storage amounts to 1,085,722 pounds of fresh frozen and 235,888 pounds of fresh not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 44.39% from last year and 12.08% from last month and fresh stocks not frozen show an increase of 19.40% over last year and a decrease of 30.14% from last month.

Mutton and Lamb stocks total 8,470,586 pounds of frozen and 199,347 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show increases of 25.85% over last year and 11.30% over last month and stocks not frozen show decreases of 22.87% from last year and 55.24% from last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 437,891 pounds; chickens 5,132,202 pounds; fowl 1,594,680 pounds; ducks 218,277 pounds; geese 277,093 pounds; turkeys 2,306,910 pounds; unclassified 3,678,732 pounds. Total poultry shows increases of 30.73% and 97.86% over last year and last month respectively.

Fish stocks total 15,473,103 pounds of fresh frozen and 7,964,267 pounds of smoked and other varieties. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 36.93% from last year and 20.45% from last month and smoked and other varieties show an increase of 18.15% over last year and a decrease of 16.63% from last month.

During the month of December 1,383,708 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 2,257,718 pounds frozen during November.
