COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS. OCTOBER 1, 1932.

The butter in cold storage amounts to 33,318,108 pounds of creamery and 257,074 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows a decrease of 18.06% from last year and an increase of 8.83% over last month; and dairy butter shows decreases of 38.73% and 24.07% from last year and last month respectively.

Chesse stocks total 21,764,008 pounds showing an increase of 3.23% over last year and a decrease of 1.61% from last month.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 11,056,447 dozen: fresh eggs 1,204,775 dozen; and frozen eggs 4,847,884 pounds. Cold storage eggs show decreases of 18.98% from last year and 7.24% from last month; fresh eggs show increases of 39.32% over last year and 21.13% over last month; and frozen eggs show decreases of 7.27% and 3.49% from last year and last month respectively.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 6,466,039 pounds; fresh, not frozen 2,463,215 pounds; cured, dry salted 369,407 pounds; cured, sweet pickled 5,050,772 pounds; in process of cure 3,052,936 pounds. Fresh frozen stocks show an increase of 57.37% over last year and a decrease of 36.96% from last month; fresh stocks not frozen show decreases of 5.15% from last year and 21.01% from last month; cured, dry salted stocks show decreases of 64.90% from last year and 47.96% from last month; cured, sweet pickled stocks also show decreases of 7.90% from last year and 16.97% from last month; and stocks in process of cure show an increase of 33.13% over last year and a decrease of 17.73% from last month.

The pure lard in storage amounts to 1,183,078 pounds showing decreases of 54.98% and 56.30% from last year and last month respectively.

Beef stocks total 2,813,003 pounds of fresh frozen; 4,988,633 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 239,320 pounds of cured; and 71,701 pounds of beef in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of .31% from last year and an increase of .77% over last month; fresh stocks not frozen show increases of 9.84% over last year and 8.55% over last month; cured stocks show an increase of 62.98% over last year and a decrease of 16.70% from last month; and stocks in process of cure show decreases of 45.87% from last year and 59.53% from last month.

The veal in storage amounts to 888,910 pounds of fresh frozen and 470,940 pounds of fresh, not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 26.80% from last year and .49% from last month; and fresh stocks not frozen show increases of 26.90% and 46.02% over last year and last month respectively.


Mutton and lamb stocks total 1,020,179 pounds of frozen and 448,669 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show a decrease of 32.64% from last year and an increase of 16.94% over last month; and stocks not frozen also show a decrease of 11.99% from last year and an increase of 22.46% over last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 104,610 pounds; chickens 514,973 pounds; fowl 276,915 pounds; ducks 163,632 pounds; geese 145,624 pounds; turkeys 707,133 pounds; unclassified 490,961 pounds. Total poultry shows an increase of 20.38% over last year and a decrease of 28.75% from last month.

Fish stocks total 19,511,996 pounds of fresh frozen and 6,825,382 pounds of smoked and other varieties. Fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of 7.28% from last year and an increase of 14.47% over last month; and smoked and other varieties also shows a decrease of 37.21% from last year and an increase of 8.72% over last month.

Fresh unfrozen fish in storage amounts to 46,724 pounds as compared with 82,548 pounds shown last month.

During the month of September 3,911,620 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 3,985,820 pounds frozen during August.




