COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, NOVEMBER 1, 1932.

The butter in cold storage amounts to 31,180,936 pounds of creamery and 135,543 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows decreases of 16.41% from last year and 3.26% from last month and dairy butter also shows decreases of 65.26% and 46.88% from last year and last month respectively.

Cheese stocks total 20,423,125 pounds showing an increase of 42.85% over last year and a decrease of 6.10% from last month.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 8,228,979 dozen; fresh eggs 519,319 dozen; and frozen eggs 4,506,244 pounds. Cold storage eggs show decreases of 13.87% from last year and 25.31% from last month; fresh eggs show an increase of 22.07% over last year and a decrease of 56.86% from last month; and frozen eggs show decreases of 12.40% and 7.05% from last year and last month respectively.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 5,236,042 pounds; fresh not frozen 2,573,412 pounds; cured dry salted 266,927 pounds; cured sweet pickled 4,451,331 pounds; in process of cure 9,624,266 pounds. Fresh frozen stocks show an increase of 20.19% over last year and a decrease of 19.02% from last month; fresh not frozen shows a decrease of 16.64% from last year and an increase of 4.65% over last month; cured dry salted stocks show decreases of 72.68% from last year and 27.74% from last month; cured sweet pickled stocks also show decreases of 27.87% from last year and 11.87% from last month; and stocks in process of cure show increases of 45.10% over last year and 19.51% over last month.

The pure lard in storage amounts to 1,912,560 pounds showing increases of 38.43% and 63.25% over last year and last month respectively.

Beef stocks total 3,294,138 pounds of fresh frozen; 5,001,555 pounds of fresh not frozen; 109,724 pounds of cured; and 37,516 pounds of beef in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 10.43% over last year and 17.10% over last month; and fresh stocks not frozen also show increases of 4.09% over last year and .40% over last month. Cured stocks show an increase of 20.96% over last year and a decrease of 54.15% from last month; and stocks in process of cure show a decrease of 16.40% from last year and an increase of 22.06% over last month.

The veal in storage amounts to 958,345 pounds of fresh frozen and 415,705 pounds of fresh not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of 20.36% from last year and an increase of 7.81% over last month; and fresh stocks not frozen show decreases of 15.66% from last year and 10.83% from last month.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 3,070,277 pounds of frozen and 382,561 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show a decrease of 49.94% from last year and an increase of 200.95% over last month, and stocks not frozen show decreases of 41.81% from last year and 14.39% from last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 118,082 pounds; chickens 543,835 pounds; fowl 424,115 pounds; ducks 155,653 pounds; geese 104,176 pounds; turkeys 348,338 pounds; unclassified 352,617 pounds. Total poultry shows decreases of 36.02% and 14.31% from last year and last month respectively.

Fish stocks total 21,706,202 pounds of fresh frozen and 7,176,304 pounds of smoked and other varieties. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 2.80% over last year and 11.18% over last month and smoked and other varieties show a decrease of 19.27% from last year and an increase of 5.05% over last month.

Fresh unfrozen fish in storage amounts to 52,195 pounds as compared with 46,324 pounds shown last month.

During the month of October 4,107,407 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 3,911,620 pounds frozen during September.
