COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, DECEMBER 1, 1932.

The butter in cold storage amounts to 26,360,858 pounds of creamery and 109,323 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows decreases of 16.01% from last year and 15.70% from last month and dairy butter also shows decreases of 62.00% and 19.52% from last year and last month respectively.

Cheese stocks total 13,228,723 pounds showing an increase of 4.65% over last year and a decrease of 35.24% from last month.

The eggs in cold storage amount to 4,123,132 dozen; fresh eggs 270,680 dozen; and frozen eggs 3,988,199 pounds. Cold storage eggs show decreases of 27.13% from last year and 50.21% from last month; fresh eggs show decreases of 8.98% from last year and 47.88% from last month; and frozen eggs also show decreases of 12.42% and 11.50% from last year and last month respectively.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 6,648,598 pounds; fresh not frozen 3,829,572 pounds; cured dry salted 409,316 pounds; cured sweet pickled 4,911,817 pounds; in process of cure 7,767,209 pounds. Fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of 15.15% from last year and an increase of 26.98% over last month; fresh stocks not frozen show increases of 5.88% over last year and 48.72% over last month; cured dry salted stocks show a decrease of 65.87% from last year and an increase of 53.34% over last month, cured sweet pickled stocks show a decrease of 31.36% from last year and an increase of 10.34% over last month; and stocks in process of cure show an increase of 25.01% over last year and a decrease of 19.30% from last month.

The pure lard in storage amounts to 1,538,627 pounds showing decreases of 20.98% and 20.07% from last year and last month respectively.

Beef stocks total 4,642,180 pounds of fresh frozen; 4,850,212 pounds of fresh not frozen; 79,133 pounds of cured; and 93,312 pounds of beef in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 10.29% over last year and 40.84% over last month; fresh stocks not frozen shows decreases of 7.85% from last year and 3.03% from last month; cured stocks show decreases of 34.30% from last year and 27.88% from last month; and stocks in process of cure show a decrease of 17.66% from last year and an increase of 6.62% over last month.

The veal in storage amounts to 894,090 pounds of fresh frozen and 359,372 pounds of fresh not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 28.10% from last year and .30% from last month; and fresh not frozen stocks show an increase of .21% over last year and a decrease of 14.17% from last month.


Mutton and lamb stocks total 4,855,998 pounds of frozen and 439,017 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show a decrease of 36.54% from last year and an increase of 58.16% over last month; stocks not frozen also show a decrease of 22.50% from last year and an increase of 14.41% over last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 127,099 pounds; chickens 1,294,817 pounds; fowl 546,434 pounds; ducks 228,053 pounds; geese 177,520 pounds; turkeys 457,388 pounds; unclassified 717,878 pounds. Total poultry shows a decrease of 48.78% from last year and an increase of 72.41% over last month.

Fish stocks total 19,953,176 pounds of fresh frozen and 7,172,537 pounds of smoked and other varieties. Fresh frozen stocks show an increase of 2.31% over last year and a decrease of 8.11% from last month; and smoked and other varieties show decreases of 25.00% and .16% from last year and last month respectively.

Fresh unfrozen fish in storage amounts to 88,501 pounds as compared with 52,195 pounds as compared with 52,195 pounds shown last month.

During the month of November 2,740,434 pounds of fish unfrozen and compared with 4,107,407 pounds frozen during October.




