COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, FEBRUARY 1, 1932.

The butter in cold storage amounts to 18,665,371 pounds of creamery and 197,350 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows an increase of 10.15% over last year and a decrease of 22.63% from last month; and dairy butter shows decreases of 49.77% from last year and 12.41% from last month.

Cheese stocks total 10,207,985 pounds showing decreases of 30.29% and 12.54% from last year and last month respectively.

Cold storage eggs amount to 1,536,215 dozen; fresh eggs 601,706 dozen; and frozen eggs 3,724,894 pounds! Cold storage eggs show decreases of 51.33% from last year and 47.09% from last month; fresh eggs show increases of 17.10% over last year and 17.90% over last month; and frozen eggs show an increase of 9.17% over last year and a decrease of 10.46% from last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 16,148,162 pounds; fresh not frozen 4,332,562 pounds; cured dry salted 538,854 pounds; cured sweet pickled 7,637,986 pounds; in process of cure 7,387,380 pounds. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 156.93% over last year and 8.15% over last month; fresh not frozen stocks show increases of 45.20% over last year and 62.53% over last month; cured dry salted stocks show a decrease of 45.88% from last year and an increase of 21.61% over last month; cured sweet pickled stocks show increases of 37.82% over last year and 13.83% over last month; and stocks in process of cure also show increases of 37.56% over last year and 32.28% over last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 3,232,928 pounds showing increases of 13.49% and 30.16% over last year and last month respectively.

Beef stocks total 5,688,420 pounds of fresh frozen; 4,536,918 pounds of fresh not frozen; 411,091 pounds of cured; and 95,592 pounds of beef in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of .62% from last year and 8.05% from last month; fresh stocks not frozen show a decrease of 5.64% from last year and an increase of 28.86% over last month; cured stocks show increases of 107.74% over last year and 122.37% over last month; and stocks in process of cure show decreases of 37.99% over last year and 43.64% from last month.


The veal in storage amounts to 666,482 pounds of fresh frozen and 276,638 pounds of fresh not frozen. Frozen stocks show decreases of 37.95% from last year and 39.51% from last month and fresh stocks not frozen show a decrease of 14.31% from last year and an increase of 16.93% over last month.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 7,016,568 pounds of frozen and 385,144 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show an increase of 38.50% over last year and a decrease of 17.53% from last month; and stocks not frozen show increases of 52.48% over last year and 90.88% over last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 342,042 pounds; chickens 4,903,578 pounds; fowl 1,366,392 pounds; ducks 191,997 pounds; geese 280,972 pounds; turkeys 2,122,479 pounds; unclassified 4,008,985 pounds. Total of poultry shows an increase of 91.73% over last year and a decrease of 4.28% from last month.

Fish stocks total 13,042,325 pounds of fresh frozen and 8,510,459 pounds of smoked and other varieties. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 42.03% from last year and 15.55% from last month; and smoked and other varieties show increases of 25.50% and 6.62% over last year and last month respectively.

During the month of January 1,504,088 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 1,383,708 pounds frozen during December.



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
• Fig. 10. A. Schematic of the model.

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
