COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, May 1, 1932

The butter in cold storage amounts to 2,816,005 pounds of creamery and 32,358 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows decreases of 45.06% from last year and 36.40% from last month; and dairy butter also shows decreases of 76.58% from last year and 48.38% from last month.

Cheese stocks total 5,934,132 pounds showing decreases of 42.83% and 22.57% from last year and last month respectively.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 3,415,915 dozen; fresh eggs 533,672 dozen; and frozen eggs 3,457,865 pounds. Cold storage eggs show a decrease of 39.61% from last year and an increase of 1,288.00% over last month; fresh eggs show a decrease of 67.08% from last year and an increase of 26.12% over last month; and frozen eggs also show a decrease of 11.45% from last year and an increase of 4.84% over last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 22,454,807 pounds, fresh not frozen 2,840,043 pounds; cured, dry salted 701,956 pounds; cured sweet pickled 7,694,547 pounds, in process of cure 7,784,429 pounds. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 167.83% over last year and 2.71% over last month; fresh stocks not frozen show decreases of 9.65% from last year and 26.18% from last month; cured dry salted stocks show a decrease of 35.90% from last year and an increase of 85.77% over last month; cured sweet pickled show increases of 20.61% over last year and 27.79% over last month; and stocks in process of cure show an increase of 30.69% over last year and a decrease of 4.54% from last month.

The pure lard in storage amounts to 3,285,971 pounds showing a decrease of 17.18% from last year and an increase of 14.75% over last month.

Beef stocks total 3,416,404 pounds of fresh frozen; 4,298,888 pounds of fresh not frozen; 232,758 pounds of cured; and 198,198 pounds of beef in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 12.27% from last year and 13.32% from last month; fresh stocks not frozen show an increase of 29.44% over last year and a decrease of 6.03% from last month; cured dry salted stocks show an increase of 4.11% over last year and a decrease of 42.19% from last month; and stocks in process of cure also show an increase of 92.66% over last year and a decrease of 5.60% from last month.

The veal in storage amounts to 483,629 pounds of fresh frozen and 446,512 pounds of fresh not frozen. Frozen stocks show a decrease of 42.81% from last year and an increase of 35.97% over last month and fresh stocks not frozen show decreases of 6.16% and 33.33% from last year and last month respectively.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 3,945,567 pounds of frozen and 161,088 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show an increase of 107.16% over last year and a decrease of 21.27% from last month; fresh stocks not frozen also show an increase of 11.68% over last year and a decrease of 9.15% from last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- Broilers 251,604 pounds; chickens 3,100,217 pounds; fowl 844,582 pounds; ducks 161,838 pounds; geese 202,826 pounds; turkeys 1,542,834 pounds; unclassified 1,597,449 pounds. Total poultry shows an increase of 134.51% over last year and a decrease of 18.74% from last month.

Fish stocks total 8,568,588 pounds of fresh frozen and 4,543,394 pounds of smoked and other varieties. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 43.03% from last year and 7.34% from last month; and smoked and other varieties also show decreases of 4.51% and 8.64% from last year and last month respectively.

During the month of April 1,013,692 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 1,117,876 pounds frozen during March.

Fresh unfrozen fish in cold storage shows a total of 48,319 pounds as compared with 54,666 pounds shown last month.
