COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, JUNE 1, 1932

The butter in cold storage amounts to 4,291,555 pounds of creamery and 93,498 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows a decrease of 49.81% from last year, and an increase of 52.89% over last month; and dairy butter also shows a decrease of 38.50% from last year and an increase of 188.95% over last month.

Cheese stocks total 7,534,505 pounds showing a decrease of 29.27% from last year and an increase of 26.98% over last month.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 8,868,936 dozen; fresh eggs 584,112 dozen; and frozen eggs 4,311,863 pounds. Cold storage eggs show a decrease of 26.58% from last year and an increase of 160.12% over last month; fresh eggs show a decrease of 43.13% from last year and an increase of 9.47% over last month; and frozen eggs also show a decrease of 25.49% from last year, and an increase of 24.70% over last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 21,593,046 pounds; fresh not frozen 3,080,101 pounds; cured, dry salted 1,048,357 pounds; cured sweet pickled 5,991,400 pounds; in process of cure 10,579,634 pounds. Fresh frozen stocks show an increase of 176.75% over last year and a decrease of 3.79% from last month; fresh stocks not frozen show increases of 9.99% over last year and 8.46% over last month; cured dry salted stocks also show increases of 19.48% over last year and 49.35% over last month; cured sweet pickled stocks show decreases of 6.42% from last year and 22.13% from last month; and stocks in process of cure show increases of 74.13% and 35.91% over last year and last month respectively.

The pure lard in storage amounts to 3,742,992 pounds showing a decrease of 14.77% from last year and an increase of 13.94% over last month.

Beef stocks total 2,975,100 pounds of fresh frozen; 3,991,801 pounds of fresh not frozen; 457,989 pounds of cured; and 175,313 pounds of beef in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 19.14% from last year and 12.86% from last month; fresh stocks not frozen also show decreases of 12.29% from last year and 7.13% from last month; cured stocks show increases of 158.21% over last year and 96.77% over last month; and stocks in process of cure show an increase of 3.97% over last year and a decrease of 11.55% from last month.

The veal in cold storage amounts to 647,739 pounds of fresh frozen and 508,044 pounds of fresh not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of 46.63% from last year and an increase of 33.93% over last month; and stocks not frozen also show a decrease of 11.45% from last year and an increase of 13.93% over last month.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 2,171,563 pounds of frozen and 140,303 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show an increase of 129.09% over last year, and a decrease of 44.96% from last month, and stocks not frozen also show an increase of 4.35% over last year, and a decrease of 12.75% from last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- Broilers 211,513 pounds; chickens 2,486,632 pounds; fowl 760,263 pounds; ducks 150,202 pounds; geese 204,096 pounds; turkeys 1,422,177 pounds; unclassified 1,132,980 pounds. Total poultry shows an increase of 163.12% over last year and a decrease of 17.29% from last month.

Fish stocks total 9,288,405 pounds of fresh frozen and 3,829,860 pounds of smoked and other varieties. Fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of 38.39% from last year and an increase of 8.40% over last month; and smoked and other varieties show decreases of 12.32% and 15.71% from last year and last month respectively.

During the month of May 1,624,034 pounds of fish were frozen, as compared with 1,013,692 pounds frozen during April.
