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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, JULY 1, 1932

The butter in cold storage amounts to 16,472,379 pounds of creamery and 334,235 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows a decrease of 20.29% from last year and an increase of 208.72% over last month and dairy butter shows increases of 24.44% over last year and 284.61% over last month.

Cheese stocks total 16,021,994 pounds showing a decrease of 16.05% from last year and an increase of 112.89% over last month.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 10,878,918 dozen; fresh eggs 829,299 dozen; and frozen eggs 5,080,973 pounds. Cold storage eggs show a decrease of 21.61% from last year and an increase of 22.30% over last month; fresh eggs show a decrease of 12.00% from last year and an increase of 41.97% over last month; and frozen eggs also show a decrease of 11.17% from last year and an increase of 17.92% over last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 18,458,251 pounds; fresh not frozen 3,121,528 pounds; cured dry salted 981,789 pounds; cured sweet pickled 5,848,455 pounds; in process of cure 8,998,818 pounds. Fresh frozen stocks show an increase of 177.52% over last year and a decrease of 13.04% from last month; fresh stocks not frozen show increases of 15.01% over last year and 3.49% over last month; cured dry salted stocks show decreases of 20.04% from last year and 6.37% from last month; stocks cured sweet pickled also show decreases of 5.95% from last year and 2.17% from last month; and stocks in process of cure show an increase of 55.04% over last year and a decrease of 11.53% from last month.

The pure lard in storage amounts to 4,256,708 pounds showing increases of 4.18% and 15.39% over last year and last month respectively.

Beef stocks total 2,329,277 pounds of fresh frozen; 3,582,569 pounds of fresh not frozen; 327,056 pounds of cured; and 162,130 pounds of beef in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 25.63% from last year and 21.55% from last month; fresh not frozen stocks also show decreases of 17.09% from last year and 9.78% from last month; cured stocks show an increase of 107.66% over last year and a decrease of 28.59% from last month; whilst stocks in process of cure show decreases of 13.09% from last year and 7.52% from last month.

Veal stocks total 715,688 pounds of fresh frozen and 453,021 pounds of fresh not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of 41.42% from last year and an increase of 15.22% over last month; and stocks fresh not frozen show decreases of 10.85% from last year and 10.47% from last month.


Mutton and lamb stocks total 1,505,656 pounds of frozen and 241,432 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show an increase of 148.21% over last year and a decrease of 30.24% from last month; and stocks not frozen show a decrease of 1.86% from last year and an increase of 76.47% over last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 195,624 pounds; chickens 1,798,635 pounds; fowl 489,106 pounds; ducks 134,919 pounds; geese 156,029 pounds; turkeys 1,179,116 pounds; unclassified 1,304,284 pounds. Total poultry shows an increase of 190.27% over last year and a decrease of 15.88% from last month.

Fish stocks total 10,173,350 pounds of fresh frozen and 5,213,414 pounds of smoked and other varieties. Fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of 33.79% from last year and an increase of 10.05% over last month; and smoked and other varieties show increases of 7.55% and 36.70% over last year and last month respectively.

During the month of June 2,450,67 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 1,624,034 pounds frozen during May.


Fresh unfrozen fish in storage amounts to 50,813 pounds.
