

COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, August 1, 1932

The butter in cold storage amounts to 25,285,329 pounds of creamery and 258,544 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows a decrease of 22.91% from last year and an increase of 53.00% over last month and dairy butter shows decreases of 37.77% and 27.03% from last year and last month respectively.

Cheese stocks total 19,355,016 pounds showing a decrease of 23.45% from last year and an increase of 20.71% over last month.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 11,210,783 dozen; fresh eggs 819,538 dozen, and frozen eggs 5,158,097 pounds. Cold storage eggs show a decrease of 21.90% from last year and an increase of 2.60% over last month; fresh eggs show decreases of 3.65% from last year and 1.26% from last month; and frozen eggs show a decrease of 11.31% from last year and an increase of 1.50% over last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 13,862,045 pounds; fresh, not frozen 2,694,800 pounds; cured, dry salted 393,713 pounds; cured, sweet pickled 6,422,165 pounds; in process of cure 11,180,032 pounds. Fresh frozen stocks show an increase of 124.39% over last year and a decrease of 26.28% from last month; fresh stocks not frozen also show an increase of 12.02% over last year and a decrease of 14.91% from last month; cured, dry salted stocks show decreases of 58.57% from last year and 60.04% from last month; cured, sweet pickled stocks show increases of 25.37% over last year and 9.53% over last month; and stocks in process of cure show increases of 93.08% over last year and 19.15% over last month.

The pure lard in storage amounts to 3,565,979 pounds showing decreases of 14.99% and 17.79% from last year and last month respectively.

Beef stocks total 2,667,515 pounds of fresh frozen; 4,094,208 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 301,878 pounds of cured; and 224,742 pounds of beef in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of 5.34% from last year and an increase of 13.96% over last month; fresh stocks not frozen show increases of 7.74% over last year and 13.06% over last month; cured stocks show an increase of 77.13% over last year and a decrease of 7.74% from last month; and stocks in process of cure show increases of 21.34% and 38.25% over last year and last month respectively.

The veal in storage amounts to 801,589 pounds of fresh frozen and 413,653 pounds of fresh, not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of 34.72% from last year and an increase of 7.76% over last month; and fresh stocks not frozen show an increase of 7.00% over last year and a decrease of 9.41% from last month.


Mutton and lamb stocks total 1,000,626 pounds of frozen and 276,780 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show an increase of 102.48% over last year and a decrease of 33.96% from last month; and stocks not frozen show increases of .12% over last year and 13.08% over last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 180,717 pounds; chickens 1,328,914 pounds; fowl 635,583 pounds; ducks 340,530 pounds; geese 148,228 pounds; turkeys 1,068,051 pounds; unclassified 911,684 pounds. Total poultry shows an increase of 153.65% over last year and a decrease of 17.89% from last month.

Fish stocks total 14,085,627 pounds of fresh frozen and 5,522,498 pounds of smoked and other varieties. Fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of 28.11% from last year and an increase of 37.96% over last month; and smoked and other varieties show increases of 5.84% and 5.75% over last year and last month respectively.

During the month of July 6,073,241 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 2,450,367 pounds frozen during June.

Fresh unfrozen fish in storage amounts to 56,197 pounds.




