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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, NOVEMBER 1, 1933.

The butter in cold storage amounts to 37,392,515 pounds of creamery and 403,243 pounds of dairy and of the creamery butter about 1,300,000 pounds are stored in creameries with mechanical refrigeration. Including the stocks in creameries added to the list March 1st, creamery butter shows an increase of 19.3% over last year and a decrease of 7.0% from last month; dairy butter also shows an increase of 197.5% over last year and a decrease of 2.0% from last month.

Cheese stocks total 27,423,515 pounds showing an increase of 34.3% over last year and a decrease of 12.9% from last month.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 9,124,107 dozen; fresh eggs 316,103 dozen; and frozen eggs 2,805,882 pounds. Cold storage eggs show an increase of 10.9% over last year and a decrease of 30.9% from last month; fresh eggs show decreases of 36.1% from last year and 45.5% from last month; and frozen eggs show decreases of 37.7% and 8.5% from last year and last month respectively.

Pork stocks are as follows:- Fresh frozen 4,018,506 pounds; fresh not frozen 2,553,211 pounds; cured dry salted 977,907 pounds; cured sweet pickled 4,008,329 pounds; in process of cure 8,478,383 pounds. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 23.3% from last year and 26.9% from last month; fresh stocks not frozen show a decrease of .8% from last year and an increase of 13.2% over last month; cured dry salted stocks show increases of 266.4% over last year and 46.4% over last month; cured sweet pickled stocks show decreases of 10.0% from last year and 10.4% from last month; and stocks in process of cure show decreases of 11.7% from last year and 3.7% from last month.

Beef stocks total 8,586,284 pounds of fresh frozen; 5,472,608 pounds of fresh not frozen; 214,493 pounds of cured; and 137,881 pounds of beef in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 160.7% over last year and 49.5% over last month; fresh not frozen stocks show increases of 9.4% over last year and 3.3% over last month; cured stocks show increases of 95.5% over last year and 6.3% over last month; and stocks in process of cure show an increase of 57.5% over last year and a decrease of 2.2% from last month.

The veal in storage amounts to 1,084,330 pounds of fresh frozen and 648,436 pounds of fresh not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 20.9% over last year and 22.0% over last month, and fresh not frozen stocks show an increase of 56.0% over last year and a decrease of 1.7% from last month.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 5,995,073 pounds of frozen and 549,236 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show increases of 95.3% over last year and 233.1% over last month, and not frozen stocks show an increase of 43.6% over last year and a decrease of 3.2% from last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- Broilers 253,007 pounds; chickens 936,370 pounds; fowl 1,015,098 pounds; ducks 161,657 pounds; geese 24,354 pounds; turkeys 274,882 pounds; unclassified 136,515 pounds. Total poultry shows increases of 36.2% and 11.2% over last year and last month respectively.


Fish in storage amounts to 17,642,225 pounds of fresh frozen and 6,033,183 pounds of smoked and other varieties. Fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of 18.7% from last year and an increase of 3.5% over last month; and smoked and other varieties show decreases of 16.3% from last year and .1% from last month.

During the month of October 3,640,305 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 2,737,193 pounds frozen during September.

Fresh unfrozen fish in storage amounts to 56,702 pounds as compared with 33,246 pounds in store at October 1st.

--The lard in storage amounts to 1,943,341 pounds showing an increase of 1.6% over last year and a decrease of 14.7% from last month.
