COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, MARCH 1st, 1933.

The butter in cold storage amounts to 9,604,637 pounds of creamery and 19,354 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows decreases of 6.14% from last year and 42.12% from last month; and dairy butter also shows decreases of 86.56% from last year and 56.26% from last month.

Cheese stocks total 10,567,262 pounds showing an increase of 33.16% over last year and a decrease of 9.17% from last month.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 87,763 dozen; fresh eggs 266,632 dozen; and frozen eggs 3,269,654 pounds. Cold storage eggs show decreases of 68.84% from last year and 79.69% from last month; fresh eggs show an increase of 6.41% over last year and a decrease of 58.77% from last month; and frozen eggs show an increase of .55% over last year and a decrease of 7.22% from last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 15,688,070 pounds; fresh, not frozen 3,707,417 pounds; cured dry salted 660,582 pounds; cured sweet pickled 5,133,714 pounds; and in process of cure 9,164,073 pounds. Fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of 22.37% from last year and an increase of 10.89% over last month; fresh not frozen stocks show an increase of 9.96% over last year and a decrease of 1.66% from last month; cured dry salted stocks show increases of 15.35% over last year and 28.46% over last month; cured sweet pickled stocks show a decrease of 34.68% from last year and an increase of 1.97% over last month; and stocks in process of cure show increases of 8.80% over last year and 16.23% over last month.

The pure lard and prime steam lard in storage amounts to 2,831,181 pounds showing increases of 3.41% and 6.68% over last year and last month respectively.

Beef stocks total 3,887,966 pounds of fresh frozen; 4,274,861 pounds of fresh not frozen; 303,412 pounds of cured; and 188,631 pounds of beef in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 22.54% from last year and 16.19% from last month; fresh stocks not frozen show an increase of 6.01% over last year and a decrease of 8.17% from last month; cured stocks show a decrease of 3.23% from last year and an increase of 32.55% over last month; and stocks in process of cure show a decrease of 19.57% from last year and an increase of 65.77% over last month.

The veal in storage amounts to 178,315 pounds of frozen and 258,423 pounds of fresh not frozen. Frozen stocks show decreases of 60.63% from last year and 46.70% from last month; and fresh stocks not frozen show increases of 7.23% over last year and 4.59% over last month.

The mutton and lamb stocks total 2,556,118 pounds of frozen and 288,392 pounds of fresh not frozen. Frozen stocks show decreases of 57.74% from last year and 31.53% from last month and fresh not frozen stocks show increases of 58.57% and 4.50% over last year and last month respectively.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- Broilers 114,014 pounds; chickens 2,458,529 pounds; fowl 619,414 pounds; ducks 190,172 pounds; geese 100,613 pounds; turkeys 1,959,287 pounds; unclassified 1,021,061 pounds. Total poultry shows decreases of 44.61% and 10.37% from last year and last month respectively.

Fish stocks total 10,599,884 pounds of fresh frozen and 4,791,994 pounds of smoked and other varieties. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 1.16% from last year and 23.69% from last month and smoked and other varieties show decreases of 29.49% and 19.60% from last year and last month respectively.

During the month of February 759,593 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 839,629 pounds frozen during January.

Fresh unfrozen fish in storage amounts to 99,114 pounds as compared with 113,184 pounds shown last month.

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




