COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, MAY 1, 1933.

The butter in cold storage amounts to 1,943,296^x pounds of creamery and 6,683 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows decreases of 30.99% from last year and 45.36% from last month and dairy butter also shows decreases of 79.35% from last year and 30.93% from last month.

Cheese stocks total 7,542,780 pounds showing an increase of 27.11% over last year and a decrease of 11.51% from last month.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 4,041,345 dozen; fresh eggs 632,086 dozen; and frozen eggs 2,700,828 pounds. Cold storage eggs show increases of 18.31% over last year and 1,353,66% over last month; fresh eggs also show increases of 18.44% over last year and 38.93% over last month; and frozen eggs show decreases of 21.89% and 7.52% from last year and last month respectively.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 17,951,781 pounds; fresh not frozen 3,902,962 pounds; cured dry salted 905,274 pounds; cured sweet pickled 6,712,554 pounds; in process of cure 9,536,206 pounds. Fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of 20.05% from last year and an increase of 25.36% over last month; fresh not frozen stocks show increases of 37.43% over last year and 19.10% over last month; cured dry salted stocks show increases of 28.96% over last year and 3.85% over last month; cured sweet pickled stocks show a decrease of 12.76% from last year and an increase of 15.89% over last month; and stocks in process of cure show an increase of 22.50% over last year and a decrease of 10.32% from last month.

The pure and prime steam lard in storage amounts to 4,159,059 pounds showing increases of 26.57% and 64.60% over last year and last month respectively.

Beef stocks total 3,441,034 pounds of fresh frozen; 3,904,765 pounds of fresh not frozen; 61,617 pounds of cured; and 224,919 pounds of beef in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show an increase of .72% over last year and a decrease of 6.52% from last month; fresh stocks not frozen show decreases of 9.17% from last year and 16.46% from last month; cured stocks show decreases of 73.53% from last year and 60.55% from last month; and stocks in process of cure show increases of 13.48% and 29.92% over last year and last month respectively.

The veal in storage amounts to 369,184 pounds of fresh frozen and 530,058 pounds of fresh not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of 23.66% from last year and an increase of 112.95% over last month; fresh stocks not frozen show increases of 18.71% over last year and 19.43% over last month.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 919,899 pounds of frozen and 140,068 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show decreases of 76.69% from last year and 53.75% from last month; and stocks not frozen also show decreases of 13.05% from last year and 24.01% from last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 84,063 pounds; chickens 1,236,009 pounds; fowl 265,859 pounds; ducks 116,132 pounds; geese 82,445 pounds; turkeys 1,449,154 pounds; unclassified 149,423 pounds. Total poultry shows decreases of 56.07% and 35.83% from last year and last month respectively.

Fish stocks total 5,939,524 pounds of fresh frozen and 4,119,073 pounds of smoked and other varieties. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 30.68% from last year and 21.07% from last month; and smoked and other varieties also shows decreases of 9.95% and .72% from last year and last month respectively.

During the month of April 1,364,204 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 1,148,815 pounds frozen during March.

Fresh unfrozen fish in storage amounts to 42,718 pounds as compared with 64,250 pounds show last month.
