COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, AUGUST 1, 1933

The butter in cold storage amounts to 33,991,255 pounds of creamery and 388,929 pounds of dairy and of the creamery butter total about 1,400,000 pounds are stored in creameries with mechanical refrigeration. Including the stocks in the creameries added to the list, creamery butter shows increases of 37.1% over last year and 69.2% over last month; dairy butter shows increases of 50.4% over last year and 82.6% last month.

Cheese stocks total 25,485,265 pounds which is an increase of 31.7% over last year and of 48.6% over last month.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 14,221,673 dozen; fresh eggs 868,253 dozen; and frozen eggs 3,322,359 pounds. Cold storage eggs show increases of 26.9% over last year and 2.7% over last month; fresh eggs show an increase of 5.9% over last year and a decrease of 4.8% from last month; and frozen eggs show a decrease of 35.6% from last year and an increase of .4% over last month.

Pork stocks are as follows: fresh frozen 13,013,533 pounds; fresh, not frozen 2,479,551 pounds; cured, dry salted 395,950 pounds; cured, sweet pickled . 5,758,962 pounds; in process of cure 10,885,228 pounds. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 6.1% from last year and 17.4% from last month; fresh not frozen stocks show decreases of 8.0% from last year and 20.9% from last month; dry salted stocks show an increase of .6% over last year and a decrease of 45.6% from last month; sweet pickled stocks show decreases of 10.3% from last year and 9.8% from last month; and pork in process of cure shows decreases of 2.6% from last year and 1.2% from last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 5,569,438 pounds, which is an increase of 56.2% over last year and a decrease of 7.2% from last month.

Beef stocks total 3,051,530 pounds of frozen; 4,081,989 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 357,447 pounds of cured; and 234,532 pounds in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks have increased 14.4% over last year and 9.9% over last month; fresh not frozen stocks decreased .3% from last year but increased 10.2% over last month; cured stocks increased 18.4% over last year and 70.2% over last month; and stocks in process of cure increased 4.6% and 15.6% over last year and last month respectively.

The veal in storage amounts to 866,891 pounds of fresh frozen and 509,558 pounds of fresh, not frozen. The fresh frozen veal shows increases of 8.1% over last year and 23.5% over last month; and fresh, not frozen veal shows an increase of 23.2% over last year but a decrease of 16.7% from last month.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 427,291 pounds of frozen and 396,471 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks registered decreases of 57.3% from last year and 16.1% from last month; not frozen stocks showed increases of 43.2% over last year and 86.5% over last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 171,364 pounds; chickens 680,461 pounds; fowl 286,163 pounds; ducks 156,976 pounds; geese 56,829 pounds; turkeys 1,126,229 pounds; and unclassified 115,146 pounds. Total poultry stocks decreased 41.2% from last year and 34.4% from last month.

Fish in storage amounts to 13,382,205 pounds of fresh frozen and 4,919,531 pounds of smoked and other varieties. Fresh frozen stocks decreased 5.0% from last year and increased 53.5% over last month; stocks of smoked and other varieties show a decrease of 10.9% from last year and an increase of 5.4% over last month.

During the month of July 8,279,112 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 5,614,118 pounds frozen during June.

Fresh unfrozen fish in storage amounts to 33,441 pounds as compared with 37,866 pounds in store on July 1.
