COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, SEPTEMBER 1, 1933.

The butter in cold storage amounts to 41,619,146 pounds of creamery and 398,897 pounds of dairy and of the creamery butter about 1,500,000 are stored in creameries with mechanical refrigeration. Including the stocks in the creameries added to the list, creamery butter shows increases of 39.3% over last year and 22.4% over last month; dairy butter shows increases of 18.0% over last year and 2.5% over last month.

Cheese stocks total 33,007,584 pounds which is an increase of 49.2% over last year and 29.5% over last month.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 14,595,856 dozen; fresh eggs 772,086 dozen; frozen eggs 3,467,158 pounds. Cold storage eggs show increases of 22.7% over last year and 2.6% over last month; fresh eggs show decreases of 22.4% from last year and 10.9% from last month; and frozen eggs show a decrease of 31.0 from last year and an increase of 4.4% over last month.

Pork stocks are as follows: Fresh frozen 9,468,947 pounds; fresh not frozen 1,946,116 pounds; cured dry salted 658,371 pounds; cured sweet pickled 4,627,567 pounds; in process of cure 9,895,153 pounds. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 7.7% from last year and 27.1% from last month; fresh stocks not frozen show decreases of 37.6% from last year and 19.3% from last month; cured dry salted stocks show a decrease of 7.3% from last year and an increase of 66.3% over last month, cured sweet pickled stocks show decreases of 23.9% from last year and 19.6% from last month; and pork in process of cure shows an increase of 1.1% over last year and a decrease of 9.1% from last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 4,477,130 pounds which is an increase of 65.4% over last year and a decrease of 19.6% from last month.

Beef stocks total 3,784,412 pounds of fresh frozen; 4,812,970 pounds of fresh not frozen; 308,211 pounds of cured; and 160,499 pounds of beef in process of cure; Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 35.6% over last year and 24.1% over last month; fresh not frozen stocks show increases of 4.7% over last year and 17.8% over last month; cured stocks increased 7.3% over last year and decreased 13.8% from last month; and beef in process of cure decreased 9.4% from last year and 31.6% from last month

The veal in storage amounts to 953,129 pounds of fresh frozen and 502,544 pounds of fresh not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 6.7% over last year and 9.9% over last month; fresh stocks not frozen show an increase of 55.8% over last year and a decrease of 1.4% from last month.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 615,076 pounds of frozen and 421,978 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show a decrease of 29.5% from last year and an increase of 43.9% over last month; and not frozen stocks show increases of 15.2% over last year and 6.4% over last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- Broilers 271,642 pounds; chickens 454,671 pounds; fowl 451,875 pounds; ducks 161,444 pounds; geese 44,293 pounds; turkeys 358,655 pounds; unclassified 81,560 pounds. Total poultry shows decreases of 31.1% from last year and 10.4% from last month.

Fish in storage amounts to 15,807,965 pounds of fresh frozen and 5,689,792 pounds of smoked and other varieties. Fresh frozen fish shows a decrease of 7.4% from last year and an increase of 17.7% over last month; smoked and other varieties show a decrease of 9.4% from last year and an increase of 15.7% over last month.

During the month of August 3,677,331 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 8,279,112 pounds frozen during July.

Fresh unfrozen fish in storage amounts to 46,730 pounds as compared with 33,441 pounds in store at August 1st.
