



COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, JANUARY 1, 1934.

The butter in cold storage warehouses and creameries amounts to 21,447,600 pounds of creamery and 249,763 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows decreases of .8% from last year and 26.2% from last month; and dairy butter shows an increase of 262.2% over last year and a decrease of 24.4% from last month.

Cheese stocks total 15,865,410 pounds showing an increase of 19.5% over last year and a decrease of 4.5% from last month.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 1,247,629 dozen; fresh eggs 196,003 dozen; and frozen eggs 2,134,903 pounds. Cold storage eggs show decreases of .8% from last year and 70.3% from last month; fresh eggs show a decrease of 29.6% from last year and an increase of 2.3% over last month; and frozen eggs show decreases of 43.7% and 15.1% from last year and last month respectively.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh not frozen 3,012,610 pounds; fresh frozen 7,603,305 pounds; and cured or in cure 13,430,055 pounds. Fresh not frozen stocks show decreases of 10.0% from last year and 29.1% from last month; fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of 40.1% from last year and an increase of 35.7% over last month and stocks cured or in cure show decreases of .2% from last year and 7.9% from last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 2,537,468 pounds showing increases of 9.1% and 58.2% over last year and last month respectively.

Beef stocks total 11,732,361 pounds of fresh frozen; 3,814,257 pounds of fresh not frozen; 228,712 pounds of cured; and 189,761 pounds of beef in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show an increase of 129.4% over last year and a decrease of 2.5% from last month; fresh not frozen stocks show an increase of 11.5% over last year and a decrease of 32.2% from last month; cured stocks show increases of 3.0% over last year and 101.4% over last month; and stocks in process of cure show an increase of 3.4% over last year and a decrease of 2.4% from last month.

The veal in storage amounts to 1,045,734 pounds of fresh frozen and 184,663 pounds of fresh not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show an increase of 49.1% over last year and a decrease of 21.0% from last month; and fresh stocks not frozen also show an increase of 2.6% over last year and a decrease of 53.5% from last month.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 6,832,187 pounds of frozen and 271,391 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show an increase of 35.4% over last year and a decrease of 6.2% from last month; and not frozen stocks show increases of 9.8% over last year and 5.5% over last month.


Stocks of poultry are as follows:- Broilers 209,276 pounds; Chickens 4,421,006 pounds; fowl 1,925,735 pounds; ducks 255,486 pounds; geese 178,469 pounds; turkeys 4,203,424 pounds; unclassified 456,366 pounds. Total poultry shows increases of 39.7% and 92.7% over last year and last month respectively.

Fish in storage amounts to 12,742,154 pounds of fresh frozen and 4,371,261 pounds of smoked and other varieties. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 25.6% from last year and 16.6% from last month and smoked and other varieties show decreases of 35.1% and 11.3% from last year and last month respectively.

During the month of December 1933, 958,531 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 2,106,574 pounds frozen during November.


Fresh unfrozen fish in storage amounts to 28,356 pounds as compared with 36,163 pounds in store at December first.
