

COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, NOVEMBER 1, 1934.

The butter in storage amounts to 49,373,180 pounds of creamery and 581,457 pounds of dairy, the creamery butter total including approximately 2,000,000 pounds reported by firms added to the list since March 1, 1934. Creamery butter shows an increase of 31.5% over last year and a decrease of 6.4% from last month; and dairy butter also shows an increase of 44.2% over last year and a decrease of 8.5% from last month.

Cheese stocks total 24,550,519 pounds showing decreases of 10.5% from last year and 28.1% from last month.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 10,592,905 dozen; fresh eggs 285,379 dozen; and frozen eggs 2,835,697 pounds. Cold storage eggs show an increase of 16.0% over last year and a decrease of 25.4% from last month; fresh eggs show decreases of 9.7% from last year and 66.0% from last month; and frozen eggs show an increase of 1.1% over last year and a decrease of 14.5% from last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh, not frozen 3,740,556 pounds; fresh frozen 3,372,438 pounds; cured or in cure 13,734,668 pounds. Fresh not frozen stocks show increases of 44.4% over last year and 51.7% over last month; fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 15.4% from last year and 23.1% from last month; and stocks cured or in cure show increases of 1.5% over last year and 6.5% over last month.

The pure lard in storage amounts to 1,627,743 pounds showing decreases of 16.2% and 9.2% from last year and month respectively.

Beef stocks total 12,561,842 pounds of fresh frozen; 6,799,827 pounds of fresh not frozen; 315,833 pounds of cured and 91,254 pounds of beef in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 46.3% over last year and 74.9% over last month; fresh not frozen stocks show increases of 24.2% over last year and 13.9% over last month; cured stocks also show increases of 47.1% over last year and 31.9% over last month; and stocks cured or in cure show decreases of 33.8% from last year and 52.9% from last month.

The veal in storage amounts to 2,100,216 pounds of fresh frozen and 930,916 pounds of fresh not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 93.7% over last year and 24.3% over last month; and fresh not frozen stocks also show increases of 43.6% and 28.0% over last year and last month respectively.


Mutton and lamb stocks total 5,777,062 pounds of frozen and 573,070 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show a decrease of 3.6% from last year and an increase of 256.4% over last month; and stocks not frozen show increases of 4.3% over last year and 38.2% over last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 211,151 pounds; chickens 1,319,055 pounds; fowl 1,110,373 pounds; ducks 163,100 pounds; geese 32,332 pounds; turkeys 164,968 pounds; unclassified 174,839 pounds. Total poultry shows increases of 13.3% over last year and 10.1% over last month.

Fish stocks total 23,903,287 pounds of fresh and frozen; and 5,990,692 pounds of smoked, dried, pickled or salted. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 35.5% over last year and 12.3% over last month; and smoked and other varieties show decreases of .7% and 12.3% from last year and last month respectively.

During the month of October 4,895,951 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 2,744,667 pounds frozen during September.
