COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, DECEMBER 1, 1934.

The butter in storage amounts to 41,110,179 pounds of creamery and 514,274 pounds of dairy, the creamery butter total including approximately 1,531,000 pounds, reported by firms added to the list since March 1, 1934. Creamery butter shows an increase of 41.3% over last year and a decrease of 15.7% from last month; and dairy butter also shows an increase of 55.7% over last year and a decrease of 11.5% from last month.

Cheese stocks total 17,884,114 pounds showing an increase of 7.7% over last year and a decrease of 27.0% from last month.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 6,041,390 dozen; fresh eggs 291,308 dozen; and frozen eggs 2,377,560 pounds. Cold storage eggs show an increase of 43.8% over last year and a decrease of 42.9% from last month; fresh eggs show increases of 52.1% over last year and 3.0% over last month; and frozen eggs show decreases of 5.4% and 16.2% from last year and last month respectively.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh, not frozen 4,216,070 pounds; fresh, frozen 6,159,433 pounds; cured or in cure 15,344,754 pounds. Fresh, not frozen stocks show a decrease of 1.0% from last year and an increase of 12.8% over last month; fresh, frozen stocks show increases of 9.9% over last year and 82.7% over last month; and stocks cured or in cure show increases of 4.7% over last year and 11.7% over last month.

The pure lard in storage amounts to 1,713,770 pounds showing increases of 6.8% and 5.4% over last year and last month respectively.

Beef stocks total 18,078,317 pounds of fresh frozen; 5,816,485 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 202,032 pounds of cured and 159,617 pounds of beef in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 50.2% over last year and 44.1% over last month; fresh not frozen stocks show an increase of 3.4% over last year and a decrease of 14.5% from last month; cured stocks show an increase of 77.9% over last year and a decrease of 36.0% from last month; stocks cured or in cure show a decrease of 17.9% from last year and an increase of 74.9% over last month.

The veal in storage amounts to 2,552,315 pounds of fresh frozen and 470,491 pounds of fresh not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 91.9% over last year and 21.6% over last month; fresh not frozen stocks show an increase of 18.3% over last year and a decrease of 49.5% from last month.


Mutton and lamb stocks total 7,424,475 pounds of frozen and 343,674 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show increases of 1.9% over last year and 28.5% over last month; and stocks not frozen show an increase of 33.6% over last year and a decrease of 40.0% from last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:-broilers 240,137 pounds; chickens 2,888,209 pounds; fowl 1,805,799 pounds; ducks 189,867 pounds; geese 242,012 pounds; turkeys 1,662,951 pounds; unclassified 372,028 pounds. Total poultry shows increases of 22.3% and 133.5% over last year and last month respectively.

Fish stocks total 22,164,090 pounds of fresh and frozen; and 5,848,389 pounds of smoked, dried, pickled or salted. Fresh and frozen stocks show an increase of 45.1% over last year and a decrease of 7.3% from last month; and smoked and other varieties also show an increase of 18.6% over last year and a decrease of 2.4% from last month.

During the month of November 2,848,545 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 4,895,951 pounds frozen during October.

Note:- Stocks of foreign produce are not included in this statement.




