

COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, FEBRUARY 1, 1934.

The butter in cold storage warehouses and creameries amounts to 14,370,551 pounds of creamery and 153,441 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows decreases of 13.0% from last year and 33.0% from last month; and dairy butter shows an increase of 240.3% over last year and a decrease of 38.6% from last month.

Cheese stocks total 13,777,917 pounds showing an increase of 18.3% over last year and a decrease of 13.2% from last month.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 116,041 dozen; fresh eggs 132,008 dozen; and frozen eggs 1,683,674 pounds. Cold storage eggs show decreases of 73.2% from last year and 90.7% from last month; fresh eggs show increases of 79.8% from last year and 32.7% from last month; and frozen eggs also show decreases of 52.2% and 21.1% from last year and last month respectively.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh not frozen 3,152,577 pounds; fresh frozen 5,868,820 pounds; and cured or in cure 14,697,680 pounds. Fresh not frozen stocks show a decrease of 16.4% from last year and an increase of 4.6% over last month; fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 58.5% from last year, 22.8% from last month; and stocks cured or in cure show increases of 9.4% over last year and 7.5% over last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 2,233,946 pounds showing decreases of 15.8% and 12.1% from last year and last month respectively.

Beef stocks total 8,498,879 pounds of fresh frozen; 4,898,025 pounds of fresh not frozen; 257,304 pounds of cured; and 116,867 pounds of beef in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show an increase of 83.2% over last year and a decrease of 19.9% from last month; fresh not frozen stocks show increases of 5.2% over last year and 28.3% over last month; cured stocks show increases of 12.4% over last year and 12.5% over last month; and stocks in process of cure show an increase of 2.7% over last year and a decrease of 38.4% from last month.

The veal in storage amounts to 636,730 pounds of fresh frozen and 241,919 pounds of fresh not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show an increase of 90.3% over last year and a decrease of 39.1% from last month; and fresh stocks not frozen show a decrease of 2.1% from last year and an increase of 31.0% over last month.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 4,925,432 pounds of frozen and 167,414 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show an increase of 31.9% over last year and a decrease of 27.9% from last month; and stocks not frozen show decreases of 39.3% from last year and 38.3% from last month.


Stocks of poultry are as follows: broilers 180,694 pounds; chickens 4,279,919 pounds; fowl 1,806,307 pounds; ducks 199,049 pounds; geese 97,320 pounds; turkeys 3,741,758 pounds; unclassified 407,999 pounds. Total poultry shows an increase of 48.2% over last year and a decrease of 4.1% from last month.

Fish in storage amounts to 9,641,281 pounds of fresh frozen and 3,228,900 pounds of smoked and other varieties. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 31.4% from last year and 24.3% from last month; and smoked and other varieties also show decreases of 45.8% and 26.1% from last year and last month respectively.

During the month of January 1,052,220 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 953,531 pounds frozen during December.

Fresh unfrozen fish in storage amounts to 35,992 pounds as compared with 28,356 pounds in store at January first.

Note:- Stocks of foreign produce held in bond are not included in this statement.
