COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, MARCH 1, 1934.

The butter in cold storage warehouses and creameries amounts to 7,056,695 pounds of creamery and 52,661 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows decreases of 27.3% from last year and 50.9% from last month; and dairy butter shows an increase of 172.1% over last year & a decrease of 65.7% from last month.

Cheese stocks total 12,150,022 pounds showing an increase of 14.9% over last year and a decrease of 11.8% from last month.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 14,701 dozen; fresh eggs 101,504 dozen; and frozen eggs 1,250,020 pounds. Cold storage eggs show decreases of 83.2% from last year and 87.3% from last month; fresh eggs show decreases of 62.0% from last year and 23.1% from last month and frozen eggs show decreases of 61.8% and 28.3% from last year and last month respectively.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh, not frozen 3,534,349 pounds; fresh frozen 8,643,686 pounds; and cured or in cure 17,587,500 pounds. Fresh, not frozen stocks show a decrease of 4.7% from last year and an increase of 12.1% over last month; fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of 44.9% from last year and an increase of 47.3% over last month; and stocks cured or in cure show increases of 17.6% over last year and 19.7% over last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 2,849,249 pounds showing increases of .6% and 27.5% over last year and last month respectively.

Beef stocks total 6,693,562 pounds of fresh frozen; 4,656,897 pounds of fresh not frozen; 204,343 pounds of cured; and 98,484 pounds of beef in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show an increase of 72.2% over last year and a decrease of 21.2% from last month; fresh not frozen stocks show an increase of 8.9% over last year and a decrease of 4.9% from last month; cured stocks show decreases of 32.7% from last year and 20.6% from last month; and stocks in process of cure also show decreases of 47.8% and 15.7% from last year and last month respectively.

The veal in storage amounts to 425,854 pounds of fresh frozen and 324,705 pounds of fresh, not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show an increase of 138.8% over last year and a decrease of 33.1% from last month; and fresh stocks not frozen show increases of 25.6% over last year and 34.3% over last month.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 3,866,964 pounds of frozen and 213,912 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show an increase of 52.1% over last year and a decrease of 21.1% from last month; and stocks not frozen show a decrease of 25.8% from last year and an increase of 27.8% over last month.


Stocks of poultry are as follows: broilers 183,479 pounds; chickens 4,128,239 pounds; fowl 1,330,466 pounds; ducks 129,172 pounds; geese 91,877 pounds; turkeys 3,393,467 pounds; unclassified 351,024 pounds. Total poultry shows an increase of 48.7% over last year and a decrease of 10.9% from last month.

Fish stocks total 6,558,022 pounds of fresh frozen and 2,547,590 pounds of smoked and other varieties. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 38.2% from last year and 32.0% from last month; and smoked and other varieties show decreases of 46.8% and 21.0% from last year and last month respectively.

During the month of February 1,410,412 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 1,052,220 pounds frozen during January.


Fresh unfrozen fish in storage amounts to 44,841 pounds as compared with 35,992 pounds in store at February first.
