COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, APRIL 1, 1934.

The butter in cold storage warehouses and creameries amounts to 3,730,484 pounds of creamery and 15,174 pounds of dairy, the creamery butter total including approximately 145,000 pounds reported by firms added to the list since March 1, 1934. Creamery butter shows an increase of 5.6% over last year and a decrease of 50.2% from last month; and dairy butter also shows an increase of 56.8% over last year and a decrease of 71.2% from last month.

Cheese stocks total 10,832,669 pounds showing an increase of 27.1% over last year and a decrease of 11.7% from last month.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 138,978 dozen; fresh eggs 247,470 dozen and frozen eggs 921,196 pounds. Cold storage eggs show a decrease of 50.2% from last year and an increase of 345.4% over last month; fresh eggs show a decrease of 45.6% from last year and an increase of 139.3% over last month; and frozen eggs show decreases of 68.5% and 26.3% from last year and last month respectively.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh, not frozen 3,467,934 pounds; fresh frozen 10,599,416 pounds; and cured or in cure 16,870,233 pounds. Fresh, not frozen stocks show an increase of 5.8% over last year and a decrease of 2.7% from last month; fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of 26.0% from last year and an increase of 20.9% over last month; and stocks cured or in cure show decreases of 2.5% from last year and 5.6% from last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 3,596,796 pounds showing increases of 42.3% and 24.9% over last year and last month respectively.

Beef stocks total 5,006,524 pounds of fresh frozen; 4,376,692 pounds of fresh not frozen; 262,161 pounds of cured; and 121,384 pounds of beef in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show an increase of 36.1% over last year and a decrease of 25.5% from last month; fresh not frozen shows decreases of 6.4% from last year and 6.9% from last month; cured stocks show increases of 67.8% over last year and 28.3% over last month; and stocks in process of cure show a decrease of 29.9% from last year and an increase of 23.3% over last month.

The veal in storage amounts to 315,747 pounds of fresh frozen and 481,576 pounds of fresh not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show an increase of 82.1% over last year and a decrease of 26.4% from last month; and fresh stocks not frozen show increases of 8.5% over last year and 49.5% over last month.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 2,580,729 pounds of frozen and 219,422 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show an increase of 29.8% over last year and a decrease of 34.1% from last month; and stocks not frozen show increases of 19.0% over last year and 2.9% over last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 179,237 pounds; chickens 3,199,215 pounds; fowl 971,237 pounds; ducks 94,981 pounds; geese 79,943 pounds; turkeys 2,667,289 pounds; unclassified 298,620 pounds. Total poultry shows an increase of 42.1% over last year and a decrease of 22.0% from last month.

Fish stocks total 5,735,043 pounds of fresh and frozen; 1,691,090 pounds of smoked; and 806,101 pounds of dried, pickled or salted. Fresh and frozen stocks show decreases of 21.7% from last year and 13.2% from last month; and smoked, pickled, dried or salted shows decreases of 34.0% and 2.0% from last year and last month respectively.

During the month of March 2,321,703 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 1,410,412 pounds frozen during February.

Note:- Stocks of foreign produce held in bond are not included in this statement.






