

COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, JUNE 1, 1934.

The butter in cold storage warehouses and creameries amounts to 6,921,630 pounds of creamery and 46,382 pounds of dairy, the creamery butter total including approximately 616,000 pounds reported by firms added to the list since March 1, 1934. Creamery butter shows increases of 29.3% over last year and 170.1% over last month and dairy butter also shows increases of 12.8% and 300.6% over last year and last month respectively.

Cheese stocks total 9,627,957 pounds showing an increase of 15.2% over last year and a decrease of 1.4% from last month.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 9,949,535 dozen; fresh eggs 684,614 dozen and frozen eggs 1,691,619 pounds. Cold storage eggs show a decrease of 13.5% from last year and an increase of 219.9% over last month; fresh eggs show increases of 41.5% over last year and 11.4% over last month; and frozen eggs show a decrease of 45.2% from last year and an increase of 104.3% over last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh not frozen 3,483,375 pounds; fresh frozen 10,945,953 pounds; and cured or in cure 16,457,009 pounds. Fresh not frozen stocks show an increase of 2.5% over last year and a decrease of 1.3% from last month; fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 41.1% from last year and 2.3% from last month; and stocks cured or in cure show decreases of 9.7% from last year and 3.9% from last month.

The pure lard in storage amounts to 4,386,362 pounds showing a decrease of 21.6% from last year and an increase of 22.4% over last month.

Beef stocks total 3,327,658 pounds of fresh frozen; 4,304,507 pounds of fresh not frozen; 174,295 pounds of cured and 134,597 pounds of stocks in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show an increase of 6.6% over last year and a decrease of 20.9% from last month; fresh stocks not frozen show decreases of 2.7% from last year and 1.0% from last month; cured stocks show decreases of 47.0% from last year and 9.0% from last month; and stocks in process of cure show a decrease of 27.5% from last year and an increase of 24.6% over last month.

The veal in storage amounts to 776,768 pounds of fresh frozen and 695,116 pounds of fresh not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 24.1% over last year and 50.9% over last month; and fresh not frozen stocks also show increases of 18.7% over last year and 7.8% over last month.

The mutton and lamb stocks total 746,522 pounds of frozen and 181,751 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show an increase of 20.5% over last year and a decrease of 58.2% from last month; and stocks not frozen show increases of 2.7% over last year and 32.5% over last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 69,920 pounds; chickens 1,570,- 956 pounds; fowl 525,260 pounds; ducks 72,083 pounds, geese 61,822 pounds; turkeys 1,651,072 pounds, unclassified 181,858 pounds. Total poultry shows an increase of 27.5% over last year and a decrease of 30.5% from last month.

Fish stocks total 6,825,855 pounds of fresh and frozen and 3,678,594 pounds of smoked, dried, pickled or salted. Fresh and frozen stocks show increases of 16.9% over last year and 25.7% over last month; and smoked and other varieties show a decrease of 8.5% from last year and an increase of 21.2% over last month.

During the month of May 2,060,598 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 2,502,337 pounds frozen during April.

Note:- Stocks of foreign produce held in bond are not included in this statement.





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
