

COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, JULY 1, 1934.

The butter in cold storage warehouses and creameries amounts to 24,328,301 pounds of creamery and 216,259 pounds of dairy, the creamery butter total including approximately 1,429,000 pounds reported by firms added to the list since March 1, 1934. Creamery butter shows increases of 20.1% over last year and 244.2% over last month and dairy butter also shows increases of 1.5% over last year and 366.3% over last month.

Cheese stocks total 17,315,855 pounds showing increases of 1.0% and 75.4% over last year and last month respectively.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 13,041,928 dozen; fresh eggs 679,906 dozen; and frozen eggs 3,091,546 pounds. Cold storage eggs show a decrease of 5.8% from last year and an increase of 30.7% over last month; fresh eggs show decreases of 25.5% from last year and 3.8% from last month; and frozen eggs show a decrease of 6.6% from last year and an increase of 44.8% over last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh not frozen 2,848,763 pounds; fresh frozen 9,649,273 pounds; and cured or in cure 16,374,976 pounds. Fresh not frozen stocks show decreases of 9.1% from last year and 18.2% from last month; fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 38.8% from last year and 12.6% from last month; and stocks cured or in cure decreases of 9.8% from last year and 1.2% from last month.

The pure lard in storage amounts to 3,656,917 pounds showing decreases of 39.1% and 17.1% from last year and last month respectively.

Beef stocks total 3,020,703 pounds of fresh frozen; 4,792,028 pounds of fresh not frozen; 170,139 pounds of cured and 137,965 pounds of beef in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show an increase of 8.7% over last year and a decrease of 9.2% from last month; fresh not frozen stocks show increases of 29.4% over last year and 11.3% over last month; cured stocks show decreases of 19.0% from last year and 2.4% from last month; and stocks in process of cure show a decrease of 32.0% from last year and an increase of 2.5% over last month.

The veal in storage amounts to 918,613 pounds of fresh frozen and 572,452 pounds of fresh not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 29.6% over last year and 18.3% over last month; and fresh not frozen stocks show decreases of 6.5% from last year and 17.6% from last month.

The mutton and lamb stocks total 343,988 pounds of frozen and 284,023 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show decreases of 32.6% from last year and 54.1% from last month; and stocks not frozen show increases of 33.7% over last year and 56.3% over last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows: broilers 81,007 pounds; chickens 1,333,871 pounds; fowl 439,055 pounds; ducks 95,692 pounds; geese 53,056 pounds; turkeys 1,516,985 pounds; unclassified 178,731 pounds. Total poultry shows an increase of 36.1% over last year and a decrease of 10.5% from last month.

Fish stocks total 10,286,440 pounds of fresh and frozen and 4,161,561 pounds of smoked, dried, pickled or salted. Fresh and frozen stocks show increases of 17.1% over last year and 50.6% over last month; and smoked and other varieties show a decrease of 10.9% from last year and an increase of 13.1% over last month.

During the month of June 4,146,780 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 2,060,598 pounds frozen during May.






