COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, AUGUST 1, 1934.

The butter in storage amounts to 41,641,390 pounds of creamery and 470,850 pounds of dairy, the creamery butter total including approximately 1,625,000 pounds reported by firms added to the list since March 1, 1934. Creamery butter shows increases of 21.3% over last year and 69.5% over last month and dairy butter also shows increases of 21.0% over last year and 118.3% over last month.

Cheese stocks total 24,697,605 pounds showing a decrease of 3.1% from last year and an increase of 51.2% over last month.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 13,771,713 dozen; fresh eggs 604,274 dozen; and frozen eggs 4,126,658 pounds. Cold storage eggs show a decrease of 3.2% from last year and an increase of 7.3% over last month; fresh eggs show decreases of 30.5% from last year and 14.3% from last month and frozen eggs show increases of 24.2% and 35.9% over last year and last month respectively.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh not frozen 1,994,972 pounds; fresh frozen 6,471,432 pounds; and cured or in cure 14,144,952 pounds. Fresh not frozen stocks show decreases of 19.6% from last year and 29.8% from last month; fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 50.3% from last year and 32.4% from last month; and stocks cured or in cure also show decreases of 17.0% and 12.5% from last year and last month respectively.

The pure lard in storage amounts to 2,884,573 pounds showing decreases of 48.2% from last year and 17.7% from last month.

Beef stocks total 3,422,832 pounds of fresh frozen; 4,946,293 pounds of fresh not frozen; 185,222 pounds of cured; and 222,945 pounds of beef in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 12.0% over last year and 13.3% over last month; fresh not frozen stocks show increases of 21.1% over last year and 3.2% over last month; cured stocks show a decrease of 48.2% from last year and an increase of 9.0% over last month; and stocks in process of cure also show a decrease of 4.9% from last year and an increase of 64.1% over last month.

The veal in storage amounts to 1,171,421 pounds of fresh frozen and 604,294 pounds of fresh not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 34.1% over last year and 27.5% over last month; and fresh not frozen stocks also show increases of 18.6% over last year and 5.6% over last month.

The mutton and lamb stocks total 366,989 pounds of frozen and 370,512 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show a decrease of 14.4% from last year and an increase of 6.7% over last month; and frozen stocks also show a decrease of 6.5% from last year and an increase of 30.5% over last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 141,951 pounds; chickens 1,134,363 pounds; fowl 449,210 pounds; ducks 132,208 pounds; geese 53,231 pounds; turkeys 1,246,969 pounds; unclassified 156,904 pounds. Total poultry shows an increase of 27.7% over last year and a decrease of 10.6% from last month.

Fish stocks total 17,274,815 pounds of fresh and frozen and 5,800,293 pounds of smoked, dried, pickled, or salted. Fresh and frozen stocks show increases of 28.5% over last year and 66.1% over last month; and smoked and other varieties show increases of 17.9% over last year and 39.1% over last month.


During the month of July 7,572,188 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 4,146,780 pounds frozen during June.
