COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, SEPTEMBER 1, 1934.

The butter in storage amounts to 50,433,021 pounds of creamery and 573,496 pounds of dairy, the creamery butter total including approximately 2,093,000 pounds reported by firms added to the list since March 1, 1934. Creamery butter shows increases of 20.0% over last year and 22.4% over last month and dairy butter also shows increases of 43.8% over last year and 21.4% over last month.

Cheese stocks total 32,054,048 pounds showing a decrease of 2.9% from last year and an increase of 29.6% over last month.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 14,758,241 dozen; fresh eggs 692,929 dozen; and frozen eggs 3,350,528 pounds. Cold storage eggs show increases of 1.1% over last year and 7.3% over last month; fresh eggs show a decrease of 10.4% from last year and an increase of 11.7% over last month; and frozen eggs also show a decrease of 3.4% from last year and an increase of 9.1% over last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh, not frozen stocks 1,883,307 pounds; fresh frozen stocks 4,628,484 pounds; and cured or in cure 12,914,839 pounds. Fresh, not frozen stocks show decreases of 3.3% from last year and 7.8% from last month; fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 51.2% from last year and 28.6% from last month; and stocks cured or in cure also show decreases of 15.0% and 10.7% from last year and last month respectively.

The pure lard in storage amounts to 2,230,835 pounds showing decreases of 50.2% from last year and 25.0% from last month.

Beef stocks total 3,940,960 pounds of fresh frozen; 5,209,769 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 225,586 pounds of cured; and 298,722 pounds of beef in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 3.8% over last year and 15.8% over last month; fresh stocks not frozen also show increases of 8.2% over last year and 4.9% over last month; cured stocks show a decrease of 26.8% from last year and an increase of 23.3% over last month; and stocks in process of cure show increases of 86.1% and 34.8% over last year and last month respectively.

The veal in storage amounts to 1,418,647 pounds of fresh frozen and 481,590 pounds of fresh, not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 47.8% over last year and 21.1% over last month; and fresh, not frozen stocks show decreases of 4.2% from last year and 20.6% from last month.


Mutton and lamb stocks total 491,528 pounds of frozen and 382,219 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show a decrease of 20.2% from last year and an increase of 34.2% over last month; and stocks not frozen also show a decrease of 9.4% from last year and an increase of 2.5% over last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 188,652 pounds; chickens 908,583 pounds; fowl 526,000 pounds; ducks 157,601 pounds; geese 37,499 pounds; turkeys 949,456 pounds; unclassified 270,260 pounds. Total poultry shows an increase of 30.6% over last year and a decrease of 8.4% from last month.

Fish stocks total 20,050,890 pounds of fresh and frozen and 6,510,796 pounds of smoked, dried, pickled or salted. Fresh and frozen stocks show increases of 26.7% over last year and 17.2% over last month; and smoked and other varieties also show increases of 14.4% and 12.6% over last year and last month respectively.

During the month of August 4,684,732 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 7,572,188 frozen during July.

Note:- Stocks of foreign produce are not included in this statement.
