

COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, JANUARY 1, 1935.

The butter in storage amounts to 31,699,532 pounds of creamery and 440,040 pounds of dairy. Of the creamery butter total 24,150,729 pounds are in cold storage plants and 7,548,803 pounds in creameries; of the latter amount approximately 1,700,000 pounds are in creameries added to the list since March 1, 1934. Creamery butter in cold storage shows an increase of 47.6% over last year and a decrease of 23.7% from last month; and butter in creameries also shows an increase of 39.5% over last year and a decrease of 17.2% from last month. Dairy butter also shows an increase of 76.2% over last year and a decrease of 14.1% from last month.

Cheese stocks total 17,104,510 pounds showing an increase of 7.1% over last year and a decrease of 4.3% from last month.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 3,473,522 dozens; fresh eggs 251,306 dozens; and frozen eggs 2,043,016 pounds. Cold storage eggs show an increase of 177.5% over last year and a decrease of 42.3% from last month; fresh eggs show an increase of 25.8% over last year and a decrease of 12.9% from last month; and frozen eggs show decreases of 4.4% and 14.1% from last year and last month respectively.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh, not frozen 2,351,552 pounds; fresh frozen 12,588,572 pounds; cured or in cure 15,499,526 pounds. Fresh, not frozen stocks show decreases of 23.6% from last year and 44.2% from last month; fresh frozen stocks show increases of 62.9% over last year and 66.4% over last month; and stocks cured or in cure show increases of 11.1% over last year and 1.1% over last month.

The pure lard in storage amounts to 2,741,799 pounds showing increases of 7.0% and 59.9% over last year and last month respectively.

Beef stocks total 17,823,046 pounds of fresh frozen; 4,536,458 pounds of fresh not frozen; 310,121 pounds of cured; and 172,061 pounds of beef in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show an increase of 67.3% over last year and a decrease of 1.3% from last month; fresh not frozen stocks show an increase of 18.5% over last year and a decrease of 22.0% from last month; cured stocks show increases of 35.6% over last year and 54.0% over last month; stocks in process of cure show a decrease of 9.3% from last year and an increase of 7.8% over last month.

The veal in storage amounts to 2,258,880 pounds of fresh frozen and 276,603 pounds of fresh not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show an increase of 115.9% over last year and a decrease of 11.2% from last month; and stocks not frozen show an increase of 49.8% over last year and a decrease of 41.2% from last month.


Mutton and lamb stocks total 7,196,284 pounds of frozen and 282,221 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show an increase of 3.9% over last year and a decrease of 3.0% from last month; and stocks not frozen show an increase of 4.0% over last year and a decrease of 17.7% from last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 176,434 pounds; chickens 4,543,093 pounds; fowl 2,264,348 pounds; ducks 255,350 pounds; geese 146,896 pounds; turkeys 3,528,053 pounds; unclassified 738,924 pounds. Total poultry shows increases of 4.2% over last year and 58.7% over last month.

Fish stocks total 18,543,855 pounds of fresh and frozen; and 4,944,922 pounds of smoked, dried, pickled or salted. Fresh and frozen fish show an increase of 45.5% over last year and a decrease of 16.1% from last month; and smoked and other varieties show an increase of 13.1% over last year and a decrease of 15.3% from last month.

During the month of December 1,704,277 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 2,848,545 pounds frozen during November.




