

COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, OCTOBER 1, 1935.

The butter in storage amounts to 54,820,017 pounds of creamery and 362,333 pounds of dairy. Of the creamery butter total 42,122,669 pounds are in cold storage plants and 12,697,348 pounds in creameries. Included in the latter are approximately 535,000 pounds contributed by creameries in Quebec which were added to the list since June 1, 1935. Creamery butter shows increases of 2.9% over last year and 5.7% over last month; and dairy butter shows decreases of 43.0% from last year and 54.9% from last month. Car-loads of butter reported by the railways in transit or at terminals and not included in the figures just mentioned amount to 1,248,800 pounds as compared with 980,000 pounds shown last month.

Cheese stocks total 29,430,936 pounds, decreases of 13.9% and 1.43% from last year and last month respectively.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 9,430,451 dozens; fresh eggs 541,563 dozens, and frozen eggs 3,946,384 pounds. Cold storage eggs show decreases of 33.6% from last year and 8.6% from last month; fresh eggs show a decrease of 3.56% from last year and an increase of 25.5% over last month; and frozen eggs show an increase of 18.4% over last year and a decrease of 6.9% from last month. In addition to these stocks car-loads of eggs reported by the railways in transit or at terminals amount to 73,650 dozens as compared with 117,840 dozens shown last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh, not frozen 1,820,113 pounds; fresh frozen 5,180,689 pounds; and cured or in cure 13,027,492 pounds. Fresh not frozen stocks show decreases of 2.62% from last year and 13.7% from last month; fresh frozen stocks show an increase of 18.1% over last year and a decrease of 23.9% from last month; and stocks cured or in cure show increases of 1.0% over last year and .3% over last month.

The pure lard in storage amounts to 3,063,260 pounds showing an increase of 71.0% over last year and a decrease of 5.0% from last month.

Beef stocks total 5,700,333 pounds of fresh frozen; 6,137,177 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 189,733 pounds of cured; and 254,976 pounds of beef in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of 2.06% from last year and an increase of 43.4% over last month; fresh stocks not frozen show increases of 2.7% over last year and 20.5% over last month; cured stocks show decreases of 20.8% from last year and 25.1% from last month; and stocks in process of cure show increases of 31.7% over last year and 7.7% over last month.


Veal in storage amounts to 1,991,736 pounds of fresh frozen and 561,576 pounds of fresh, not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 17.9% over last year and 24.4% over last month; and fresh, not frozen stocks show a decrease of 23.0% from last year and an increase of 16.4% over last month.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 1,080,810 pounds of frozen and 448,851 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show a decrease of 33.3% from last year and an increase of 98.0% over last month; and stocks not frozen show increases of 8.2% over last year and 61.4% over last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 216,250 pounds; chickens 609 pounds; fowl 334,990 pounds; ducks 172,275 pounds; geese 43,013 pounds; turkeys 513,501 pounds; unclassified 185,322 pounds. Total poultry shows decreases of 3.13% and 11.1% from last year and last month respectively.

Fish stocks total 21,311,671 pounds of fresh and frozen and 4,716,809 pounds of smoked, dried, pickled or salted. Fresh and frozen stocks show increases of .1% over last year and 13.5% over last month; and smoked and other varieties show a decrease of 29.6% from last year and an increase of 5.4% over last month.


