



COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, NOVEMBER 1, 1935.

The butter in storage amounts to 47,474,219 pounds of creamery and 366,579 pounds of dairy. Of the creamery butter total 36,169,228 pounds are in cold storage plants and 11,304,991 pounds are in creameries. Included in the latter are approximately 364,000 pounds contributed by firms in Quebec and Ontario that were added to the list since June 1, 1935.

Creamery butter shows decreases of 3.9% from last year and 13.1% from last month; and dairy butter shows a decrease of 37.0% from last year an increase of 1.1% over last month. Car-loads of butter reported by the railways in transit or at terminals and not included in the figures just mentioned amount to 448,000 pounds as compared with 1,248,800 pounds shown last month.

Cheese stocks total 28,237,103 pounds showing an increase of 14.4% over last year, and a decrease of 4.9% from last month.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 6,458,100 dozens; fresh eggs 243,090 dozens; and frozen eggs 3,382,534 pounds. Cold storage eggs show decreases of 39.0% from last year and 31.3% from last month; fresh eggs also show decreases of 14.8% from last year and 55.4% from last month; and frozen eggs show an increase of 19.3% over last year and a decrease of 12.9% from last month. In addition to these stocks car-loads of eggs reported by the railways in transit or at terminals amount to 88,380 dozens as compared with 73,650 dozens shown last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh, not frozen, 3,158,963 pounds; fresh, frozen 5,334,315 pounds; cured or in cure, 14,575,223 pounds. Fresh, not frozen stocks show a decrease of 15.5% from last year and an increase of 71.7% over last month; fresh frozen stocks show increases of 58.2% over last year and 6.5% over last month; and stocks cured or in cure show increases of 6.1% over last year and 11.7% over last month.

The pure lard in storage amounts to 2,434,579 pounds showing an increase of 49.6% over last year and a decrease of 22.2% from last month.

Beef stocks total 11,611,364 pounds of fresh frozen; 7,543,976 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 179,755 pounds of cured and 213,741 pounds of beef in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of 950,478 pounds or 7.6% from last year and an increase of 5,923,988 pounds or 104.2% over last month; fresh, not frozen stocks show increases of 10.9% over last year and 22.9% over last month; cured stocks show decreases of 43.1% from last year and 4.9% from last month; and stocks in process of cure show an increase of 122,487 pounds or 134.2% over last year and a decrease of 48,235 pounds or 18.4% from last month.


Veal in storage amounts to 2,357,925 pounds of fresh frozen and 1,032,598 pounds of fresh, not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 12.3% over last year and 18.7% over last month; and fresh, not frozen stocks also show increases of 10.9% and 83.4% over last year and last month respectively.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 3,890,080 pounds of frozen and 619,663 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show a decrease of 1,886,982 pounds or 32.7% from last year and an increase of 2,809,182 pounds or 260.0% over last month; and stocks not frozen show increases of 8.1% over last year and 37.8% over last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 206,230 pounds; chickens 1,163,833 pounds; fowl 608,426 pounds; ducks 183,146 pounds; geese 48,728 pounds; turkeys 190,455 pounds; unclassified 229,483 pounds. Total poultry shows a decrease of 17.2% from last year and an increase of 34.6% over last month. Stocks of poultry in transit or at terminals reported by the railways and not included in the above figures amount to 66,000 pounds.

Fish stocks total 25,912,843 pounds of fresh and frozen and 5,585,275 pounds of smoked, dried, pickled or salted. Fresh and frozen stocks show increases of 8.4% over last year and 13.4% over last month; and smoked and other varieties show a decrease of 6.8% from last year and an increase of 2.4% over last month.


